**MINUTES**

Items No. 1:

To report and record the recognition order dated 03-03-2023 of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) with regard to starting of the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) in the college.

The college had sent the proposal to University of Delhi for starting of ITEP under NEP 2020. The University vide its letter dated 24-05-2022 gave its no objection for the course and thereafter the college applied for the ITEP in the NCTE. The NCTE after following due procedure awarded the recognition order dated 03-03-2023 for the starting of the ITEP in the following three disciplines namely:

The Principal apprised the Governing Body members about the emergent meeting held in the University on 29-03-2023 with the Registrar, Director, South Campus and the Principals of the four colleges namely Mata Sundari College, Jesus and Mary College, Lakshmi Bai College and SPM College who had applied for the ITEP course in NCTE. The Registrar informed that the Vice-Chancellor had announced that the University is starting the ITEP course from the Academic Year 2023. During the meeting, SPM College agreed to start the ITEP course from the academic session 2023-24. The Registrar also informed that the University would likely to discontinue the B.El.Ed course from next year.

The Governing Body unanimously resolved that the college is ready to start the ITEP course with one unit from the Academic Session 2023-24. The college may start the second unit from the next academic session.

However, the college will abide by the decision of the University of Delhi for future course of action.
