**Guidelines and Timings for Canvassing in the College as pr the  
University Notification and Code of Conduct for the DUSU Elections  
2023.**

- No candidate contesting election for Office-bearers of the Students' Council of College and DUSU will be allowed to enter in the college for the purpose of canvassing without proper identification i.e. College Identity Card or any Identity Slip issued by the Office of Chief Election Officer.
- The Candidate will be allowed to enter in the college with a maximum of four supporters with a valid DU-ID Card.
- Candidates may utilize only handmade posters for the purpose of canvassing in accordance to NGT orders OA Number 402/2015 dated 18<sup>th</sup> July 2016.
- Canvassing time for the DUSU Elections in the College is between 11.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. The candidate may use the Wall of Democracy for canvassing purpose.
- No candidate shall deface or cause any destruction to any property of the college / campus for any purpose whatsoever. All candidates shall be held jointly and severely liable for any destruction / defacing of college property as per Code of Conduct of DUSU Elections 2023.

All the students are informed that Election of SPM College Students' Council for the year 2023-24 will be held on **22.09.2023**. The last date for receipt of Nomination papers along with Demand Draft of Rs.500/- and Affidavit is **12.09.2023** up to 3.00 p.m.

**ELEGIBILITY FOR CANDIDATES**

- \* Candidates for all posts should have at least 55% marks in their previous Examination. (Copy of Marksheet, fee receipt and ID card to be attached with nomination paper)
- \* The candidate filling nominations should have been regular students of the College from 1st year of the course.
- \* The candidate filling nominations should have minimum attendance of 75 % as per University norms.
- \* The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election. Any pending paper(s) will be construed as academic arrear(s). Candidates failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current academic year will not be eligible to contest the election.
- \* Only those Undergraduate students between the ages of 17 and 25 years as on 16<sup>th</sup> August of the year of elections may contest elections.
- \* The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office-bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of executive member. No candidate can contest simultaneously for more than one post.
- \* Every contesting candidate is required to furnish an affidavit, along with the Security Deposit i.e. Rs.500/- demand draft in the name of Principal, SPM College on or before 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2023.
