

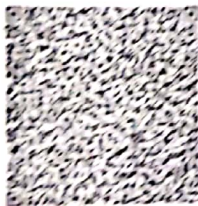

SUSTAINABLE INITIATIVES, an organization, its registered office at B-1556 Shastri Nagar, New Delhi 110052 is working in the field Environment Education and Awareness generation in educational institutes and as well as providing consultancy services in different fields of Environment herein referred to as FIRST PARTY.

AND

SHYAMA PRASAD MUKHERJEE COLLEGE, is located at Road No. 57, Punjabi Bagh New Delhi is a deemed college of Delhi University, herein referred to as SECOND PARTY

I. Purpose and Scope

- A. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to engage Sustainable Initiatives LLP working as "Knowledge Partner" for E-Waste and Environment Education and awareness related Projects" to fulfill, successfully execute the obligations of SPM COLLEGE identified and arising out of its Agreement. Such "Knowledge Partner" shall be working in collaboration with SPM College on environment on workshops, knowledge exchange sessions, presentations on Environment AND E-Waste related projects.
- B. SPM COLLEGE has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) dated 20th JAN 2019 with "SUSTAINABLE INITIATIVES", whereby the Parties to the MoU have identified their roles and responsibilities and have joined hands in providing strategic collaboration for capacity building of students and teachers in areas of environmental education and awareness.
- C. Both Parties have ensured each other that the various activities are conducted and shall be conducted in future in compliance with all applicable and existing laws, rules, and regulations.

II. Scope of the MoU:

1. Conducting E-waste drives on a yearly basis in the college
2. Awareness campaigns for the students in collaboration with the college to on life cycle of e-waste
3. Conducting any other environmental related programmes on different fields
4. Advocacy in the field of Environment, Climate Change, Energy and Sustainable Development

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING IS MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:

I. MOU Term

The term of this MOU Agreement is the period commencing from Feb 2019 and shall terminate Feb 2022 and the aforesaid can be mutually extended as per the terms & conditions agreed upon by both the parties

II. SPM College Responsibilities

1. SPM College shall provide the inputs for conducting the E-waste drives and themes of workshops to be conducted in the college premises
2. The college shall be responsible for arranging the venue, projectors and other equipments required for successfully conducting the workshops.
3. The college shall support the Knowledge Partner in interacting with students and logistical arrangements required if any.

III. KNOWLEDGE PARTNER(SUSTAINABLE INITIATIVES) Responsibilities

1. Conduct E-waste drives in college on a yearly basis including the workshop, advocacy, presentations and entire E-waste collection drive

2. Act as a Knowledge Partner/ Support/ Co-developer/ Project Implementer for implementing the projects in various themes of environment.
3. Co-develop and organize workshops including the presentation material, speakers, etc. to conduct E-waste drive and other environment workshops in the college.

IV. **Commercial Sharing**

There is no commercial sharing at present. If there are any financial costs involved, that would be mutually discussed between both the parties.

V. **Modification and Termination**

1. This agreement may be cancelled or terminated by either party by giving a written notice of Thirty (30) days.
2. Any and all amendments must be made in writing and must be agreed to and executed by the parties before becoming effective.

VI. **Execution and Commitments**

That, this MOU may be executed in one or more counterparts including counterparts transmitted by facsimile, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which signed and taken together, shall constitute one and the same instrument.

VII. **Dispute Resolution**

The Parties shall put all their endeavors towards settling all disputes and differences amicably through consultation and negotiation.

VIII. **Effective Date and Signature**

This MOU shall be effective upon the signature of Shyama Prasad Mukherjee College and "Sustainable Initiatives" authorized officials.


