NAME OF THE EVENT: Cleanliness Awareness Rally in two phases

PARTICIPANTS: 30 on 25; 25 on 26th and 40 on 31st NSS Volunteers along with a few faculty members and the Program Coordinator Dr. Chandrakanta K. Mathur.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

A Cleanliness Awareness rally was a subsidiary program of 'Swacchta Pkhwada', organised in two phases by NSS volunteers. In the **first phase**, in order to make the denizens aware about cleanliness and hygiene, volunteers went to the Central Market at Punjabi Bagh. The volunteers interacted with shopkeepers, food stall owners, fellow students and citizens to make them realize the importance of a neat and clean neighborhood. They also suggested methods to keep the market clean. In the **second phase**, on 26th August 2016, NSS volunteers went for a Door to Door Campaign in Punjabi Bagh Residential Colony. Volunteers met residents of Punjabi Bagh and interacted with them about the importance of a clean household. NSS Volunteers along with Program Officer Dr. Chandrakanta K. Mathur took out an Awareness Rally with banners and placards. The students raised slogans such as "Clean India My dream India" and took the streets of Punjabi Bagh to raise awareness about clean society. Dr Nita Kumar, the principal, encouraged the volunteers participation and stressed on the need to have a clean and green campus for a better learning process. .

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: Vittiya Saksharta Abhiyaan: NSS UNIT, Shyama Prasad Mukherji College took the initiative to educate the masses about cashless methods. The process began on 26th December 2016 and ended on 11th of January 2017. This project of teaching people began with a Seminar on 'Cashless Methods', followed by fieldwork where volunteers of NSS taught methods like PayTM, Mobiwink, etc. in their neighborhoods and nearby markets. The fieldwork ended on 11th of January 2017 and forms have been submitted. The Seminar began with a great start. NSS Program Officer Dr. Chandrakanta K. Mathur gave a motivational speech and a PowerPoint presentation was shown to the students to make them understand about various payment methods. Bank officials of different banks came together to teach students about cashless payment methods. Another cashless payment method was introduced by a student of SPM College. Fieldwork began on 27th of December. Various groups have been divided ranging from north campus to Punjabi Bagh to Rohini East to Karol Bagh. Volunteers taught Cashless Payment methods to people of different backgrounds ranging from their market area to neighborhood.

NAME OF THE EVENT: Swacchta Pakhwada Cleanliness Drive and Awareness Rally

PARTICIPANTS: 35 Volunteers and two teachers; 200 Volunteers and 20 teachers.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

With the spirit to contribute to "Swaccha Bharat Abhiyan", the Prime Minister's initiative, Swacchta Pakhwada Cleanliness Drive was organised on 3rd August 2017, followed by an Awareness rally on 11 August 2017. The college was divided into 5 zones, namely - Canteen Area, Ground -1, Ground -2, Garden Area and the Foyer Area. 35 volunteers worked in teams and cleaned each zone by sweeping the floors, picking bottles, polyethene and other haphazard materials and raising awareness among students to recycle paper. Various students joined volunteers and supported the initiative. Raghuvir Nagar Slum adopted by our college NSS was the venue for rally for awareness. Students marched with slogans like - "Clean India My Dream India." The March was followed by a poster-making competition, bringing the creativity of students on paper. PARTICIPANTS: 10 students volunteers in the first phase, 40 and 26 in the other two phases.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The NSS unit of the college under the convenorship of Dr. Chandrakanta K. Mathur organised the 'Swacchta Pakhwada Week' on the theme 'Clean India, Green India'. The activities of the volunteers were divided in multiple phases. In the first phase- 10 Students Volunteer of NSS cleaned College grounds by picking up wastes such as plastic bottles and by using brooms

1. Campus Cleaning
2. Gardening

In the second phase, 25 Students Volunteers along with NSS Program Officer Dr. Chandrakanta K Mathur cleaned the garden by removing weeds and watered the plants. This campus cleaning drive lasted for 30 minutes and about 25 students cleaned the college area together. Around 40 NSS Volunteers took the broom and cleaned the college ground and Gazebo area.

In the Final Phase, after the Campus Cleaning initiative, the volunteers of SPM College NSS cleaned the area outside the Campus. It included roads, car-parking area outside the College gate. About 25 students took the responsibility of keeping area around SPM College clean. The cleaning drive lasted for 2 hours.
