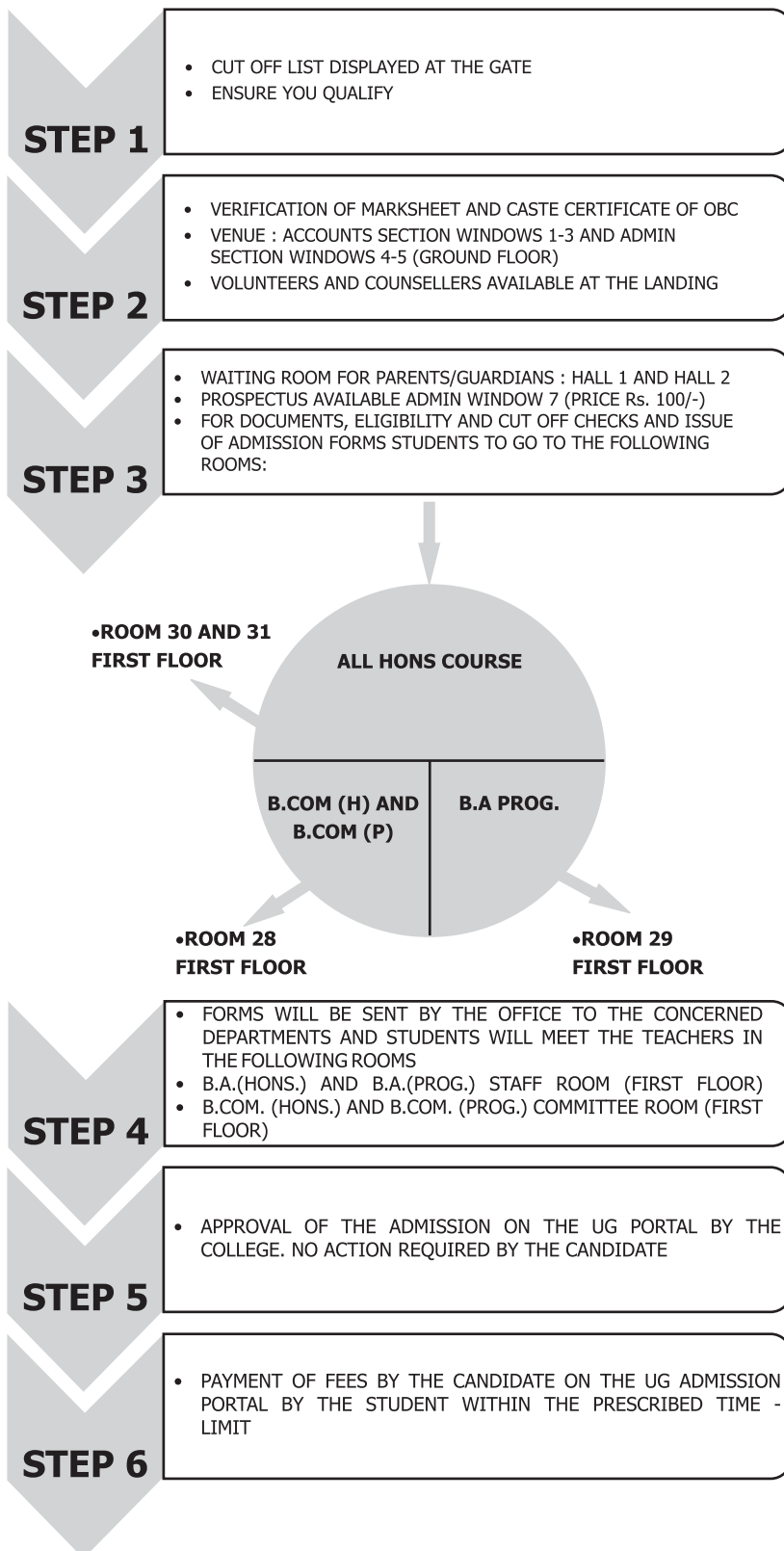

2. After approval of admission, the applicant has to log on to the undergraduate admission portal to make online admission fee payment. This may be done till 12:00 noon of the last day of that cut-off in which applicant is taking admission.

The Further cut-off lists may be declared, depending on the vacant seats in the college.

2.3 Requirements for Admission

2.3.1 Qualifying Examinations

Qualifying examinations for the purpose of admission to the first year of undergraduate programmes offered by the University of Delhi shall be Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (Class XII) of the Central Board of Secondary Education or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto.

Applicants seeking admission to the programmes offered by the University should have passed the qualifying examination obtaining minimum marks as specified for each of the programmes in subsequent sections.

2.3.2 Age Requirement

As per Ordinance-I of the University, there is no minimum age bar for admission to the undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in the University and its colleges except in the programmes where the respective regulatory bodies, such as Medical Council of India (MCI), All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), Bar Council of India (BCI), National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), Dental Council of India (DCI), etc. have prescribed the minimum age requirement in their regulations.

Gap year(s) would not be a bar for purposes of admission to the undergraduate programmes.

2.3.3 Equivalence Criteria

The applications for admission to the Undergraduate programme in the College in respect of applicants belonging to the Examining bodies of Boards/Universities recognized/accredited by the Association of Indian University/ University Grants Commission/Ministry of Human Resource Development shall be considered by the College/ in terms of the following recommendations as circulated in the University circular letter of 13-1-2005.

- 2.3.3a That various degrees from Universities recognized by the Association of Indian Universities/University Grants Commission/Ministry of Human Resource Development or by any bilateral agreement be considered as equivalent to corresponding degrees of University of Delhi subject to the conditions that course duration is same as in Delhi University for purposes of determining eligibility for admission to various programme and further College may evolve procedure through its Admission Committee.
- 2.3.3b Senior School Certificate of various Boards recognized by Association of Indian Universities/ Central Board of Secondary Education is considered as equivalent to the Senior School Certificate of Central Board for the purposes of eligibility to various Undergraduate Programmes.
- 2.3.3c Students who pass various Degree/School Examination of Foreign Universities/Boards as have already been approved by the Equivalence Committee, from time to time, be considered eligible as a matter of routine. The cases of only those candidates who do not fall in the list of Association of Indian Universities/University Grants Commission/Ministry of Human Resource Development recognized accredited Boards/Universities shall be referred to the University on the basis of individual merit.
- 2.3.3d **For some board which issue consolidated mark-sheets containing marks of both 11th and 12th class the merit of such applicants shall be determined on the basis of such consolidate marksheet.**

The admission in any Programme/Course shall not be granted on the basis of projected scores issued by any Board/School.

2.3.4 Grade Conversion [As per AC Resolution No. 319, Dt. 22.3.1976]

Formula/equivalence of the grade point average awarded in Cambridge School Certificate/ Malayalam / Overseas /African G.C.E./Examination School Certificate Examination and / or 12th Grade Examination of American Embassy School, New Delhi with the percentage of marks as are awarded in the Higher Secondary Examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, for the purpose of admission to different Programmes in the University of Delhi.

- * Wherever G.C.E. Certificate indicates the grades; it will be treated at par with the grades of Indian School Certificate Examination for purposes of Admission requirements. (See Grade Conversion)
- * The applicants seeking admission to an Honours programme must have passed the subject at Advanced level.

In case any board declares the percentage marks of individual subjects along with the grades, then marks shall be taken into consideration.

The marks so arrived at will then be considered for calculation of 'Best Four'.
2. The applicant must have studied and passed Mathematics/Business Mathematics at the qualifying examination for admission to B.Com. (Hons.).
3. The computation of 'best four' subjects in the above framework should lead to an effective and unique 'best four' which would be higher than any other combination of 'best four' subjects.

2.5 Procedure for Calculating 'Best Four'

2.5.1 Procedure for calculation of 'Best Four' subjects percentage for Honours Programmes (For admission to Arts/ Humanities Programmes):

- The merit shall be determined on the basis of one language and three best academic/elective subjects from LIST A.
- Out of three, academic/elective subject chosen above, one must be the concerned subject in which the admission is sought, failing which a deduction of 2.5% will be imposed on the calculated 'Best Four' percentage.
- For Honours in languages refer to point 7 also.

Note:

- If an applicant doesn't include the subjects given in LIST A in 'Best Four', then a deduction of 2.5% of maximum marks will be levied for each subject for the purpose of calculating 'Best Four'.
- All subjects to be included in the calculation of 'Best Four' must have at least 70% theory component of exam. In case, the subject to be considered does not have 70% theory component and 30% practical component, then the marks of theory and practical only shall be converted to 70% and 30%, respectively on pro rata basis. These new marks will then be considered for calculation of 'Best Four'.

Examples

- If an applicant has scored: Physics 90 (theory 50, practical 40; max. marks theory 60, practical 40), and Chemistry 91 (theory 52, practical 39; max. marks theory 60, practical 40) which is not in ratio of 70: 30, then the marks can be converted on pro rata basis

Pro rata marks in physics = 88.33; $((50/60) \times 70 + (40/40) \times 30) = 58.33 + 30 = 88.33$

Pro rata marks in chemistry = 89.92; $((52/60) \times 70 + (39/40) \times 30) = 60.67 + 29.25 = 89.92$

- If an applicant has scored: Physics 88 (theory 45, IA 14, practical 29; max. marks theory 56, IA 14, practical 30), Chemistry 92 (theory 48, IA 14, practical 30; max. marks theory 56, IA 14, practical 30), English (90) and Biology 95 (theory 51, IA 14, practical 30; max. marks theory 56, IA 14, practical 30). Mathematics 92. The marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology have less than 70% theory component and therefore have to be converted to 70:30 ratio on pro rata basis.

For Physics, it is $56.25 + 29 = 85.25$; $((45/56) \times 70 + 29) = 56.25 + 29 = 85.25$

For Chemistry, it is $60 + 30 = 90$; $((48/56) \times 70 + 30 = 60 + 30 = 90$

For Biology, it is $63.75 + 30 = 93.75$; $((51/56) \times 70 + 30 = 63.75 + 30 = 93.75$

The following discipline subjects must be treated as Academic/ Elective subjects for the purpose of undergraduate admissions. All other subjects offered by different boards may be treated as nonelective.

Basis of calculation of Best Four

- Accountancy shall be treated at par with academic/ elective subjects.
- Mass Media Studies will be treated as an academic subject for the purpose of admission to B.A. (Hons.) Journalism (Hindi/ English).
- In case an applicant has studied elective and core languages, the core/elective language subject will be treated as language, while elective language can be considered as academic/elective subject.
- Admission to B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology will be based on 'Best Four' percentage as in B.A. (Hons.) Psychology.
- Admission to B.A. (Hons.) Philosophy B.A. (Hons.) will be based on 'Best Four' percentage including one language and three academic/elective subjects as per the above procedure.
- The applicants must have studied and passed Mathematics at the qualifying exam for admission to B.A. (Honours) in Economics.
- For admission to Honours in any language programme, advantage of 2% in the 'Best Four' percentage will be given to those applicants who have studied that particular elective language.
 - In case, an applicant has not studied a language at qualifying exam and is seeking admission to Honours in that language (except for Honours in English and Hindi, refer (c)), deduction of 5% will be imposed on 'Best Four' percentage.
 - For admission to Honours in English and Hindi, the applicant must have studied and passed the respective language in the qualifying exam and should include respective language for calculation of 'Best Four' percentage.
- University may define any other relevant subjects as an academic/ elective for a particular Honours programme.

Example 1:

If an applicant has scored:
Accounts (90), Business
Studies (92), English Core
(88) and Economics (94).

Total marks are
 $90+92+88+94=364$,
Percentage is 91%.

The effective percentage for:

B.A. (Hons.) English is 91%,

Total marks in PCBE are:

The effective percentage for:

B.A. (Hons.) English is 87.5%

B.A. (Hons.) Political Science is $87.5\% - 2.5\% = 85\%$

If an applicant has scored: English Elective (92), History (65), Political Science (85), Geography (89) and Home Science (90).

Total Marks = 356 excluding History.

2.5.2 Procedure for calculation of 'Best Four' subjects percentage for B. Com. (Honours)/B.Com.:

One Language from Part 1 of List C1 + three best subjects out of Part 2 of List C1.

OR

One Language from Part 1 of List C1 + any combination of subjects out of Part 2 of List C1, List C2 or any other subject (not listed either in List C1 or List C2). In such a case, the deduction of marks from aggregate percentage of 'Best Four' shall be as follows:

- i. For every subject included from List C2, a deduction of one percent in aggregate percentage of 'Best Four';
- ii. For every other subject (not listed either in List C1 or List C2), a deduction of 2.5% per subject in aggregate percentage of 'Best Four'.

Note:

1. All subjects to be included in the calculation of 'Best Four' must have at least 70% theory component of examination. In case the subject to be considered does not have at least 70% theory component, then the marks obtained in theory and practical shall be converted to 70% and 30% respectively, on pro rata basis. The marks so arrived at will then be considered for calculation of 'Best Four'.
2. The applicant must have studied and passed Mathematics/Business Mathematics at the qualifying examination for admission to B. Com. (Hons.).
3. The computation of 'best four' subjects in the above framework should lead to an effective and unique 'best four' which would be higher than any other combination of 'best four' subjects.

Case 1 is unique "best four", so effective percentage for both B.Com. (Hons.) &

B.Com. is 86.75%

*Marks in physics/chemistry/biology papers should be in ratio of 70: 30 (theory: practical), otherwise, marks calculated on pro rata basis will be considered.

2.5.3 Procedure for calculation of 'Best Four' subjects percentage for B.A. programme:

- One Language (Core/Elective/Functional)
- Any three elective subjects can be chosen. A deduction of upto 5% on 'Best Four' percentage may be imposed if there is a change of stream, which means either from Commerce stream to Arts/Humanities/Social Sciences or from Science stream to Arts/Humanities/Social Sciences..
- One non-listed (LIST A) subject can be included in calculation of 'Best Four' without any deduction.
- If an applicant opts for Modern Indian Language (MIL) (Except Hindi) as a subject, an advantage of up to 10% may be given in 'Best Four' in those colleges where MIL is offered as a subject.

Note:

- The college will notify the actual deduction upto 5% for change of stream beforehand by uploading on its website.
- If more than one non-listed subject is included for calculation of 'Best Four', a deduction of 2.5% each in 'Best Four' may be levied in addition to deduction due to change of stream, if any.
- All subjects to be included in the calculation of 'Best Four' must have at least 70% theory component of exam. In case, the subject to be considered does not have 70% theory component and 30% practical component, then the marks of theory and practical only shall be converted to 70% and 30%, respectively on pro rata basis. These new marks will then be considered for calculation of 'Best Four' in addition to Note (i).

Examples for calculation of 'Best Four' Percentage are given below.

7. OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Certificate (in the name of the Applicant) as in central list issued by <http://ncbc.nic.in>
8. Transfer Certificate from school / college as well as Migration Certificate from Board / University are required from those students who have passed senior secondary exam from outside Delhi
9. At least two passport size self-attested photographs.

The College will accept self-attested copies of documents / papers provided by the students. It is made clear that if any false attestation / falsified records are detected, the student will be debarred from attending any programme in the University / or its Colleges for next five years and in addition, a criminal case under relevant sections of IPC (viz. 470, 471, 474 etc.) will be instituted against her.

2.7 Reservations and Relaxations

2.7.1 Reservation of Seats for Schedule Caste (SC)/Tribe (ST) Applicants

- 22.5 % of the total numbers of seats is reserved for applicants belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes (15% for Scheduled Caste and 7.5% for Scheduled Tribes, interchangeable, if necessary).
- Relaxation to the extent of 5% in the minimum marks will be given to the applicants belonging to SC and ST to determine their eligibility and merit for admission to the programme concerned.
- In case, after giving 5% relaxation, the reserved seats still remain vacant, further relaxation would be given to the extent required in order to fill up all the reserved seats.(AC Resolution A88, 14.6.1983) (EC Resolution 157, 24.12.2001). Eligibility in these cases is pass percentage.



Note: SC/ST students who get admission under open merit (unreserved) will not be included in the reserved quota, i.e. 22.5%.

Candidates seeking admission under SC/ST/OBC category should have certificates in their own name only.

2.7.2 Reservation of Seats for Non-Creamy layer (Central List) Other Backward Classes (OBC)

- 27% seats will be reserved for the applicants belonging to OBC (non-creamy layer, central list).
- The certificate must mention non-creamy layer status of the applicant (Non-creamy layer status issued by an authority mentioned in DOPT Office Memorandum no. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 15.11.1993).
- The OBC applicants who belong to the 'Non-Creamy Layer' and whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs only, shall be eligible to be considered for admission under the OBC category (Validity period of OBC certificate in respect of 'creamy layer' status of the applicants as per DOPT Office Memorandum No. 36036/2/2013-Estt.(Res-I) dated 31 March 2016). The validity of the non-creamy layer certificate shall be for the financial year 2016-2017.
- If the applicants do not have the OBC non-creamy layer certificate of the financial year 2016-2017 at the time of upload, the applicant may upload old OBC non-creamy layer certificate/acknowledgement slip of OBC non-creamy layer certificate application. However, at the time of admission, the applicant will have to produce the OBC non-creamy layer certificate of the financial year 2016-2017.
- The OBC applicants shall be given a relaxation of 10% in the minimum eligibility marks of the said programme and in the admission entrance test 10% of the minimum eligibility marks prescribed for General Category applicants.
- The College shall not refuse admission to any OBC applicant on the basis of medium of instruction. Any deficiency in the knowledge of any particular language should be removed, remedial classes for which may be arranged by utilizing grants that are available from University Grants Commission.
- If the seats meant for OBC remain vacant after arriving at the minimum eligibility, the same may be converted and filled up by other eligible applicants subject to approval from the University.

Note: The merit list for the unreserved category seats will comprise of all the applicants in the order of merit. No one will be excluded from the same. In other words, it will also include SC / ST / OBC applicants, if they come in unreserved merit. The applicant cannot be excluded from the unreserved category merit list just because he belongs to SC/ST/OBC. Such an applicant is entitled to be considered under the unreserved category, as well as under the reserved

category. Admission to unreserved category seats will be strictly in the order of merit without excluding SC/ST/OBC applicants.

2.7.3 Reservation of Seats for Persons with Disabilities (PwD) (Supernumerary Seats)

As per the provisions of Rights of persons with disabilities Act 2016 not less than 5% seats are reserved for persons with Benchmark Disabilities. For further details please refer to Bulletin of Information 2018-19 (University of Delhi) Concessional/Waiver of fees in respect of Persons with Disabilities (PwD)

1. Consequent upon amendment to Ordinance X(4) of the University, the following provision has been added after Sub-clause 2 of Ordinance X (4) of the said Ordinance: "Provided that the Persons with Physical Disabilities shall be waived off all the fees payable including the Examination fee and other University fees, except Admission fee, subscription towards Delhi University Students' Union and Identity Card fee for pursuing under-graduate, post-graduate or other courses in the University or its Colleges." In pursuance of the above, the students with physical disabilities pursuing various courses of study shall be exempted from payment of fees, including examination fee and other University fees, except Admission fee, subscription towards Delhi University students' Union and Identity Card fee.
2. PwD Applicants who will meet the cut-off for the unreserved category and will take admission in the unreserved category (UR) will pay fee relevant for PwD Applicant
3. In pursuance of the Executive Council Resolution No. 50 dated 03.11.2012, it is notified that the students with physical disabilities residing in different Hostels/Halls of the University are exempted from payment of all hostel fees and charges except refundable caution fee and the mess fees. The Persons with Physical Disabilities students shall pay 50% of the Mess fee and the remaining 50% of the Mess Fee-in respect of the PwD students is being met by the University.

It is clarified further that the PwD students who are getting fellowships/financial assistance shall be exempted from payment of fees/charges/mess fees subject to the following conditions:

Up to Rs. 3000/- per month	Fees waiver + 50% Mess Subsidy
Rs. 3001 to 8000 per month	Fees waiver but no Mess Subsidy

All Eligible SC/ST, OBC, PwD students who are admitted to the college should submit their scholarship form by February, 2019 for processing.

2.7.4 Reservation of Armed Forces (CW) (Supernumerary Seats)

1. All Applicants seeking admission to various undergraduate programmes of University of Delhi will have to register online as per schedule notified by the University.
2. 5% of seats are reserved for candidates under CW categories Programme wise.
3. All the CW candidates have to upload the Educational Concession certificate in the enclosed format to be issued by any of the following authorities on the proper letter head.
 - Secretary, Kendriya Sainik Board, Delhi.
 - Secretary, Rajya Zila Sainik Board.
 - Officer-in-Charge, Record Office.
 - 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate.
 - Ministry of Home Affairs (For Police Personnel in receipt of Gallantry Awards)
4. Admission may be offered to the Children/Widows of Officers and Men of the Armed Forces including Para-Military Personnel, in the following order of preference:
 - I. Widows/Wards of Defence personnel killed in action;
 - II. *Wards of serving personnel/ex-servicemen disabled in action and Boarded out from service with disability attributable to military service,
 - III. Widows/Wards of Defence personnel who died in peace time with death attributable to military service;
 - IV. *Wards of Defence personnel disabled in peace time with disability attributable to the military service; and
 - V. Wards of serving Ex-servicemen personnel including personnel of police forces who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards;

*Subject to approval of competent Bodies

Gallantry Awards include: Param Vir Chakra, Ashok Chakra, Sarvottam Yudh Seva Medal, Maha Vir Chakra, Kirti Chakra, Uttam Yudh Seva Medal, Vir Chakra, Shaurya Chakra, Yudh Seva Medal, Sena, Nau Sena, – Vayusena Medal, Mention-in-Despatches, President's Police Medal for Gallantry, Police Medal for Gallantry.

2.7.5 Reservation of Kashmiri Migrants (Supernumerary Seats)

1. All the Wards of Kashmiri Migrants who wish to be considered for admission to various undergraduate programmes for university have to register online as per schedule notified by the University.
2. Upto 5% seats are reserved programme-wise for Wards of Kashmiri Migrants.
3. All the Wards of Kashmiri Migrants will have to upload a certificate of registration as Kashmiri Migrants issued by Divisional Commissioner/Relief Commissioner.
4. A concession of maximum 10% in the last cut-off marks fixed for unreserved category applicants shall be extended to the Kashmiri Migrants.
5. Admission of Wards of Kashmiri Migrants will be based on cut-offs to be announced by the College.
The applicants selected under Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme for J&K will be admitted directly to college.

2.7.6 Reservation of Seats for Foreign Applicants (Supernumerary Seats)

All foreign applicants, including those who have completed their schooling from an Indian Board may be treated as Foreign Students for the purpose of their registration / admission in the College and they may be considered for admission under 5% quota prescribed for the foreign students. The foreign applicants seeking admission to Undergraduate Programmes should apply online through Foreign Students' Registry portal <http://fsr.du.ac.in> and can contact Deputy Dean (Foreign Students), Conference Centre, University of Delhi-110007 for further details.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION ON THE BASIS OF SPORTS IN UNDER-GRADUATE PROGRAMMES 2018

1. The applicants are required to fill the online application form available on the DU UG Portal.
2. The charges for registration will be Rs. 100/- per Game/Sport in addition to charges for (UR/OBC/SC/ST/PwD) registration.

The admission on the basis of Sports will be based on (a) Super Category: Direct admission without Sports Trial (b) Admission on the basis of Sports Trial. The list of Game/Sport of the constituent Colleges is given in Annexure VI and the list of Position/Event/Weight Category of Game/Sport of the constituent Colleges is given in Annexure VII.

I. Super Category : Direct Admission without Sports Trial

(Category A-1 of the Criteria for Marking of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate)

Sportspersons who have represented India in the under-mentioned Competition(s), recognized and funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) will be given Direct Admission without Sports Trial and will be only applicable in the Colleges where requirement for the Game/Sport has been given by the Colleges.

1. Olympic Games by the International Olympic Committee (IOC)
2. World Championship / World Cup by International Sports Federations (ISFs)
3. Commonwealth Games by Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF)
4. Asian Games by Olympic Council of Asia (OCA)
5. Asian Championships by International Sports Federations (ISFs)
6. South Asian Federation Games (SAF) by South Asian Sports Council (SASC)
7. Paralympic Games by International Paralympic Committee (IPC)

II. Admission on the basis of Sports Trial

(Categories A-2, B-1, B-2, C and D of the Criteria for Marking of Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate)

A. Maximum 40 Marks for Merit/Participation Sports Certificate

1. Criteria for Marking of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate displays the Marks for different levels of Game/Sport Competitions.
2. Sports Certificate of Invitational / Memorial / Open / Prize Money League / Ranking Competitions will not be considered.
3. Applicants are required to upload Self-Attested copies of three Merit/Participation Sports Certificate. However, only the Highest Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate will be considered for Marking.
4. Merit/Participation Sports Certificate of preceding three years will be considered from 01st May 2015 to 30th April 2018.
5. Level of competency of the applicant will be determined only for those who have achieved distinction only during the preceding three years in those Games/ Sport recognized by AIU / MYAS in which Inter-University Competitions are held and preferences are given by the constituent Colleges.

B. Maximum 60 Marks for Sports Trial

Sports Trial includes Game/Sport Specific Fitness, Fundamental Skills and Overall Playing Ability.

1. The Applicant should go through the notifications issued by the College and University of Delhi on their Website.
2. The College will conduct Sports Trial for a specific Game/Sport identified by Delhi University Sports Council (DUSC).
3. The College will video-graph the Sports Trial.
4. The Applicant must secure minimum 30 marks in the Sports Trial to be eligible for admission on the basis of Sports.

2.10 Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) :

The CBCS provides an opportunity for the students to choose courses from the prescribed courses comprising core, elective/minor or skill based courses. The courses can be evaluated following the grading system.

Outline of Choice Based Credit System :

1. **Core Course** : A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course.
2. **Elective Course** : Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill is called an Elective Course.
 - 2.1 **Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course** : Elective courses may be offered by the main discipline/subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective. The University/Institute may also offer discipline related Elective courses of interdisciplinary nature (to be offered by main discipline/subject of study).
 - 2.2 **Dissertation/Project** : An elective course designed to acquire special/advanced knowledge, such as supplement study/support study to a project work, and a candidate studies such a course on his own with an advisory support by a teacher/faculty member is called dissertation/project.
 - 2.3 **Generic Elective (GE) Course** : An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek exposure is called a Generic Elective.

P.S.: A core course offered in a discipline/subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/subject and vice versa and such electives may also be referred to as Generic elective.
3. **Ability enhancement Courses (AEC)/Competency Improvement Courses/Skill Development Courses/Foundation Course** : The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses may be of two kinds: AE Compulsory Course (AECC) and AE Elective Course (AEEC). "AECC" courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement. They ((I)Environmental Science, (ii) English/MIL Communication) are mandatory for all disciplines. AEEC courses are value-based and/or skill-based and are aimed at providing hands-on-training, competencies, skills, etc.
 - 3.1 **AE Compulsory Course (AECC)** : Environmental Science, English Communication/MIL Communication.
 - 3.2 **AE Elective Course (AEEC)** : These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based instruction.

2.15 B.Ed. AND B.El.Ed. COURSES

The College runs two professional teacher training courses namely Bachelor of Education (B.Ed), a two year course that prepares teacher for the secondary and senior secondary level and B.El.Ed., a four year programme that prepares teachers for the elementary level (Class I-VIII). The admission to both these courses is done by the Dept. of Education, University of Delhi through a centrally conducted admission test. The eligibility conditions for B. El. Ed. & B.Ed. are as follows:-

Eligibility for Admission to the B.El.Ed Programme

1. Candidates seeking admission to B.El.Ed Programme should have cleared the higher secondary examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks.
2. The reservation and relaxation in the marks for SC/ST/OBC/PwD and any other categories shall be as per the rules of the University of Delhi.

Specific details should be obtained from the Central Institute of Education, University of Delhi.

B.Ed.

A. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR B.Ed. PROGRAMME*

Candidates with at least 50% either in Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Science/Social Science/Humanities/Commerce, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent there to, are eligible for admission to the programme.

(*as per the NCTE Norms and Regulations, 2014-notified in Gazette of India)

AND

B. ELIGIBILITY FOR CHOOSING THE TEACHING SUBJECT

The candidate will have to choose only one subject (within a subject category) which she must have studied in the qualifying degree i.e., Bachelor's Degree or Master's Degree for at least 200 marks and obtained at least 50% in this subject.*

PAYMENT RULES

3.1 हमारे बारे में

The infrastructure and amenities include a spacious building, gardens, sprawling lawns and playgrounds, a state-of-the art fully air-conditioned Auditorium, a fully computerized Library, a well-equipped Gym, well-furnished classrooms, Computer labs, Psychology lab, Food & Technology lab, Seminar hall, Audio Visual room, and

various other facilities. We have a web access centre that is freely accessible for the students. All the labs, seminar hall and 30 classrooms are equipped with projectors.

The College offers various undergraduate and post-graduate courses in Humanities and Commerce streams. The College also offers Teacher's Training Programmes - B.Ed & B.El.Ed. We are proud to say that SPM is among the few colleges of the University of Delhi to have a B.Ed. course outside the Central Institute of Education (CIE), University of Delhi.

Besides offering full-time courses, the College also runs centres for the Non Collegiate Women's Education Board and the School of Open Learning over the weekend. The College has a Family Counselling Centre for students established by the Social Welfare Board, Delhi.

The student demography of the College is heterogeneous. Government norms for the reserved categories are duly followed in the admission process. North-Eastern States are well represented in the College. Students from Tibet are also enrolled in the institution. Special provisions are in place for differently-abled students and staff members. The College provides adequate infrastructure support such as ramp, wheel chairs, washrooms, and special pavements for their movement within the college premises.

SPM College is located in Punjabi Bagh (West), New Delhi. It is well connected by the Shivaji Park Metro Station.

With an academically challenging curriculum and a thriving extra-curricular environment, the College is committed to preparing young women to face the challenges of the modern world.

DEPARTMENTAL PROFILES

अनुप्रयुक्त मनोविज्ञान विभाग

महाविद्यालय में अनुप्रयुक्त मनोविज्ञान विभाग की स्थापना वर्ष 2006 में हुई थी। महाविद्यालय के सबसे नवीन विभागों में से एक होने के कारण इस विभाग का परिपोषण और संवर्द्धन एक पौधे के समान किया गया है जो अब महाविद्यालय के द्वारा प्रस्तावित अन्य पाठ्यक्रमों के साथ उन्नति कर रहा है। विषय के रूप में मनोविज्ञान मानव व्यवहार का वैज्ञानिक अध्ययन है तथा अनुप्रयुक्त मनोविज्ञान के दृष्टिकोणों और निष्कर्षों को मानव व्यवहार एवं अनुभवों की व्यावहारिक समस्याओं के निराकरण में प्रयोग करता है। विभाग छात्राओं को मानव जीवन घटना के अनुसंधान के अवसर उपलब्ध कराता है तथा समाज की घटनाओं के प्रति संवेदनशील भी बनाता है। इसके अतिरिक्त केवल पेशेवर मनोवैज्ञानिक बनने में ही नहीं बल्कि ऐसे उत्तरदायी एवं संवेदनशील व्यक्ति बनने में भी सहायता करता है जो मानव विविधता का सम्मान एवं उसका पोषण करता है।

विभाग निम्नलिखित पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करता है—

- स्नातक (विशेष)
- सामान्य ऐच्छिक

अनुप्रयुक्त मनोविज्ञान के स्नातक कार्यक्रम को इस प्रकार से निर्मित किया गया है कि यह मनोविज्ञान के विभिन्न उप ज्ञानक्षेत्रों में सैद्धांतिक और प्रायोगिक दोनों में दक्षता प्रदान करता है, जैसे— अनुप्रयुक्त समाज मनोविज्ञान, नैदानिक मनोविज्ञान (संगठनात्मक व्यवहार, शोध—प्रविधि और विकासात्मक मनोविज्ञान) इत्यादि। इनके अनुपूरक रूप में मूल्यांकन एवं शोध के विभिन्न प्रकारों में छात्राओं के प्रशिक्षण के लिए व्यावहारिक पत्र भी सम्मिलित किए जाते हैं। शिक्षण और अधिगम की प्रक्रिया के संवर्द्धन के लिए विभिन्न

शिक्षण प्रविधियों जैसे—केस स्टडी, व्याख्यान, श्रव्य—दृश्य साधन, भूमिका निर्वहण, परियोजना, आन्तरिक प्रपत्र प्रस्तुति, संगोष्ठी विशिष्ट वक्ताओं द्वारा परिचर्चा, फिल्म प्रदर्शन एवं कार्यशालाओं का आयोजन किया जाता है।

महाविद्यालय में सन् 2007 से प्रतिवर्ष मानसिक स्वास्थ्य दिवस आयोजित किया जाता है।

Department of Applied Psychology

The department of Applied Psychology was established in the year 2006 in the college. Being one of the youngest departments of the college it has been nurtured and groomed like a sapling which is now thriving along with other courses offered by the college. Psychology as a subject is the scientific study of human behavior and applied psychology uses approaches and findings of psychology to resolve practical difficulties of human behavior and experience. The department offers the students opportunities to probe into the human phenomenon and sensitize them towards the happenings of society and help them not only in becoming professional psychologists but responsible and sensitive individuals who respect & nurture human diversity.

Courses offered by the department include:

- **B.A. Honors**
- **Generic Elective**

The undergraduate program of Applied Psychology has been designed in such a way that it provides both theoretical as well as practical knowledge in various sub-domains of psychology such as Applied Social Psychology, Clinical Psychology, Organizational Behavior, Research Methodology and Developmental Psychology etc. All these papers are supplemented with practicum papers for training students in different forms of assessment and research. To enhance teaching and learning process, various pedagogical tools are used such as case studies, lectures, audio-visual aids, role-plays, projects, in-house paper presentations, seminars, talks by eminent speakers, movie screenings, and workshops.

कंप्यूटर विज्ञान विभाग

श्यामा प्रसाद मुखर्जी महाविद्यालय के कंप्यूटर विज्ञान विभाग की स्थापना सन् 1999 में हुई थी। विभाग निम्नलिखित पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करता है—

- कंप्यूटर विज्ञान में स्नातक (बी.एस.सी.)
- बीए (प्रोग्राम) में कंप्यूटर अनुप्रयोग

कंप्यूटर विज्ञान विभाग का लक्ष्य छात्राओं में गुणवत्तापूर्ण शिक्षा के अवसरों को उपलब्ध कराते हुए उन्हें एक उत्तरदायी व्यवसायी और श्रेष्ठ नागरिक बनाना है। पाठ्यक्रमों की संरचना विद्यार्थियों के विभिन्न रोज़गार योजनाओं और विशेष रुचि को ध्यान में रखते हुए कंप्यूटर विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में अकादमिक अनुभव प्रदान करने की दृष्टि से की गई है।

विभाग विभिन्न अंतरानुशासनिक पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करता है और अनेक विषय जैसे—सिस्टम एडमिनिस्ट्रेशन, वेब डिजाइनिंग, सॉफ्टवेयर इंजीनियरिंग से लेकर ऑपरेशनल रिसर्च, डिजिटल इलैक्ट्रानिक्स और टेक्निकल राइटिंग भी इसमें शामिल हैं। अन्य विभाग की छात्राओं के लिए सामान्य ऐच्छिक पाठ्यक्रम, सैद्धांतिक एवं प्रायोगिक दोनों संरचनाओं के अन्तर्गत विषय की संकल्पना की समझ प्रदान करता है।

प्रत्येक वर्ष औसतन 50 छात्राएं ग्रीष्मकालीन प्रशिक्षण और इंटर्नशिप के लिए जाती हैं। विभाग इसमें अनौपचारिक दिशा—निर्देशों और अनुकरणात्मक साक्षात्कारों (साक्षात्कारों के अभ्यासों) द्वारा छात्राओं की सहायता करता है। ऐसे कार्यक्रमों के माध्यम से प्रतिष्ठित कंपनियों और संस्थानों में छात्राओं के नियोजन में सहायता मिलती है। रोज़गार के अवसरों को बढ़ाने के क्रम में विभाग उन संस्थानों, कंपनियों और संगठनों की सहायता से संगोष्ठियों एवं ज्ञानवर्द्धक सत्रों को आयोजित करता है जो विद्यार्थियों को सूचित, प्रशिक्षित एवं नियोजित करने के लिए आगे आते हैं।

प्रत्येक अकादमिक सत्र में कंप्यूटर विज्ञान समिति सक्रिय रूप से राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठियों, सम्मेलनों, प्रपत्र प्रस्तुतियों, एसीएम विद्यार्थी संबंधित गतिविधियों, नवाचारी परियोजनाओं, प्रशिक्षु कार्यक्रमों, कार्यशालाओं, तकनीकी समारोहों, प्रशिक्षणों, समूह निर्माण गतिविधियों और प्रश्नोत्तरी का आयोजन करता है। ऐसी गतिविधियाँ पूरे अकादमिक सत्र के दौरान आयोजित की जाती हैं जिसमें सभी महत्वपूर्ण पक्ष जैसे विषय का परिज्ञान, परिमाणात्मक योग्यता, मौखिक योग्यता, समूह परिचर्चा, मनोमितीय परीक्षण एवं व्यक्तिगत साक्षात्कार इत्यादि सम्मिलित हैं। विभाग के पास अच्छी साधन संपन्न एवं सुसज्जित कक्षाएं हैं और साथ ही इण्टरनेट, श्रव्य उपकरणों एवं दृश्य प्रक्षेपकों (विजुअल प्रोजेक्टर) की सुविधाओं से युक्त कंप्यूटर प्रयोगशालाएं भी हैं।

Department of Computer Science

The Department of Computer Science at SPM College came into being in the year 1999. The Department offers the following courses:

- **B.Sc. (Hons.) Computer Science**
- **Computer Applications in B.A. (Prog.)**

The vision of the Computer Science Department is to create quality learning opportunities amongst students and to make them responsible professionals and good citizens. The courses are designed to provide academic experiences in the field of computer science for students with varied career plans and special interests.

The department offers a range of interdisciplinary courses and covers a variety of subjects from system administration, web designing, software engineering, to operational research, digital electronics and technical writing. For the students of other departments, Generic Elective courses provide the students with an understanding of the concepts both in the theoretical and practical framework.

On an average 50 students every year go for summer training programs and internships. The department helps students to prepare for these through informal guidance and mock interview sessions. This has helped in the placement of many students in reputed companies and institutes. In order to enhance employment opportunities, the department organizes seminars and informative sessions with the help of other institutions, companies, and organizations that come forward to inform, train and recruit the students.

In each academic session the Computer Science Society actively organizes national seminars, conferences, paper presentations, ACM student chapter activities, innovative projects, internship programs, workshops, technical festivals, trainings, team building activities, and quizzes. These activities are conducted all through the academic session covering all crucial aspects like subject knowledge, quantitative aptitude, verbal ability, group discussions, psychometric test and personal interviews etc. The department has good and well-equipped classrooms and computer laboratories with facilities like Internet access, audio aids, and visual projectors.

अर्थशास्त्र विभाग

अर्थशास्त्र विभाग महाविद्यालय के सबसे पुराने विभागों में से एक है और इसकी स्थापना वर्ष 1969 में हुई थी। वर्तमान में विभाग निम्नलिखित पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करता है—

- अर्थशास्त्र में स्नातक
- बीए प्रोग्राम में अर्थशास्त्र विषय
- अर्थशास्त्र के अतिरिक्त अन्य स्नातक विषयों के लिए सामान्य ऐच्छिक पाठ्यक्रम

उपर्युक्त सभी पाठ्यक्रमों के मुख्य विषय में व्यक्ति तथा समष्टि अर्थशास्त्र पर बल देते हुए उपभोक्ता व्यवहार की समझ, उत्पादक व्यवहार, धन—सृजन, मूल्य एवं ब्याज दर निर्धारण आदि सम्मिलित है। इसके साथ ही ये पाठ्यक्रम छात्राओं को विकास, रोज़गार, बाह्य—प्रखंड संतुलन, राजकीय कर निर्धारण तथा व्यय—नीति के भारतीय आर्थिक अनुभव संबंधी क्षेत्रों से परिचित कराते हैं।

स्नातक (विशेष) पाठ्यक्रम के लिए गणितीय अभिवृत्ति की विशेष आवश्यकता होती है और इसमें गणितीय अर्थशास्त्र, सांख्यिकी एवं अर्थमिति के पत्र सम्मिलित हैं।

स्नातक (विशेष) पाठ्यक्रम में छात्राएं जिन विश्लेषणात्मक साधनों का ज्ञान प्राप्त करती हैं, उनसे उन्हें पर्यावरणीय अर्थशास्त्र, स्वास्थ्य अर्थशास्त्र एवं अंतर्राष्ट्रीय व्यापार के मुद्दों के विश्लेषण की समझ प्राप्त होती है।

हालांकि स्नातक (विशेष) पाठ्यक्रमों के शिक्षण का माध्यम अंग्रेजी है किंतु विषय की बेहतर समझ के लिए प्रायः द्विभाषिक शिक्षण का उपयोग किया जाता है।

विभाग की अर्थशास्त्र सभा अपनी छात्राओं को संकाय सदस्यों के निर्देशन में पाठ्यक्रमेतर गतिविधियों जैसे वाद—विवाद, प्रश्नोत्तरी, चर्चाएं आदि के लिए एक मंच उपलब्ध कराती है।

इन पाठ्यक्रमों द्वारा प्राप्त दक्षता का रोज़गार के क्षेत्र में बहुत महत्व है और हमारी कई छात्राओं ने बैंकिंग, सॉफ्टवेयर, गैर सरकारी संस्थानों, विद्यालय एवं महाविद्यालय शिक्षण में सफलतापूर्वक रोज़गार प्राप्त किए हैं। पिछले कुछ वर्षों में हमारी कुछ छात्राओं ने भारतीय और विदेशी विश्वविद्यालयों के अत्यंत प्रतिष्ठित पाठ्यक्रमों में प्रवेश भी प्राप्त किया है।

Department of Economics

The Department of Economics is one of the oldest departments of the college and was established in 1969. At present the department offers the following courses:

- **B.A. Honors**
- **Economics in B.A. Programme**
- **Generic Elective courses for B.A. Honors in subjects other than Economics.**

The core papers in all these courses cover topics in Microeconomics and Macroeconomics with focus on understanding consumer behavior, producer behavior, money creation, determination of prices, rate of interest etc. In addition these courses also expose students to Indian economic experience in the areas of growth, employment, external sector balance, government taxation and expenditure policy.

The Honors course requires a good deal of mathematical aptitude and includes papers on Mathematical Economics, Statistics and Econometrics. The analytical tools the students learn in the Honors courses enable them to analyze issues in Environmental Economics, Health Economics and International Trade.

The medium of instruction is English for Honors courses, though bilingual teaching is often practiced for a better understanding of the subject.

The Economics Association of the department offers a platform to the students, under the guidance of a faculty member, to organize co-curricular activities like debates, quizzes, discussions etc.

The skills acquired in these courses are highly valued in the job market and many of our students have successfully built their careers in banking, software companies, NGOs and teaching in schools and colleges. In the last few years, some of our students have secured admissions in post graduate courses in some of the prestigious Indian and foreign universities.

शिक्षा विभाग

शिक्षा विभाग दो व्यावसायिक कार्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करता है:

- **प्राथमिक शिक्षा में स्नातक (बी.एल.एड)**— यह चार वर्षीय शिक्षक प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम है, जिसमें उन्हीं छात्राओं द्वारा प्रवेश लिया जा सकता है जिन्होंने +2 स्तर की शिक्षा पूरी कर ली है। यह पाठ्यक्रम प्राथमिक स्तर पर पढ़ाने के लिए शिक्षकों को तैयार करता है।
- **शिक्षा में स्नातक (बी.एड)**— यह दो वर्षीय शिक्षक प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम है जिसमें स्नातक अथवा स्नातकोत्तर के बाद प्रवेश लिया जा सकता है। यह उच्च माध्यमिक स्तर तक के लिए शिक्षकों को तैयार करता है।

विभाग अपनी छात्राओं के संपूर्ण विकास के लिए योग्य एवं समर्पित संकाय सदस्यों के निर्देशन में विभिन्न पाठ्यक्रम—एवं—पाठ्यक्रमेतर गतिविधियों के माध्यम से उनके विकास के लिए प्रयासरत है। महाविद्यालय अपनी छात्राओं को आधुनिकतम आधारभूत सुविधाएं व अधिगम—संसाधन उपलब्ध कराता है। एल.सी.डी. प्रोजेक्टर, कंप्यूटर कक्ष और अच्छे पुस्तकालय के साथ विभाग का अपना एक संसाधन कक्ष भी है। यहां कम्प्यूटर की सुविधा, बाल—साहित्य का एक अच्छा संग्रह, किताबें, श्रव्य—दृश्य संसाधन, शिक्षण—खिलौने एवं अन्य शिक्षण अधिगम सामग्री भी उपलब्ध है।

विभाग अपनी छात्राओं को विभिन्न प्रकार के अधिगम अनुभव प्रदान करने का इच्छुक है जिसमें पूरा ध्यान अधिगम प्रक्रिया में सक्रिय भागीदारी पर है। छात्राओं के संवर्धन के लिए राष्ट्रीय स्तर की संगोष्ठियाँ, चर्चाएं, कार्यशालाएं और व्यवसायियों एवं विषय के विशेषज्ञों के साथ उनकी बातचीत आदि का नियमित रूप से आयोजन किया जाता है। विभिन्न संस्थानों का शैक्षणिक भ्रमण दोनों पाठ्यक्रमों की एक अन्य विशेषता है। हमारी छात्राओं ने हमें अपनी उपलब्धियों से हमेशा गौरवान्वित किया है। हमारी बहुत सी छात्राओं ने विश्वविद्यालय में स्थान प्राप्त किया है व हमारी पूर्व—छात्राएं प्रतिष्ठित विद्यालयों और महाविद्यालयों में नियोजित हैं। विभाग का एक नियोजन प्रकोष्ठ भी है जो इस पूरे प्रयास में सहायक है।

विभाग एक ऐसे भविष्य की कल्पना करता है, जहाँ वह सशक्त और सहृदय शिक्षकों का एक नेटवर्क विकसित कर सके, जो अपने समुदाय की चिन्ताओं के प्रति संवेदनशील हों। अपनी छात्राओं को चिंतनशील व्यवसायी और मौजूदा व्यवस्था में परिवर्तन की सूत्रवाहक बनाने के लिए भी विभाग सक्रिय रूप से प्रयासरत है।

Department of Education

The Department of Education offers two professional programmes in Education:

- **Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed) is a four-year teacher preparation programme that can be undertaken by students who have completed +2 level of education. It prepares teachers who are eligible to teach up to the elementary level.**

पर्यावरण अध्ययन विभाग

खाद्य प्रौद्योगिकी विभाग

खाद्य प्रौद्योगिकी विभाग अतिरिक्त दक्षता एवं स्वरोजगार के अवसर प्रदान करने के उद्देश्य से बी.ए. (प्रोग्राम) की छात्राओं के लिए खाद्य तकनीक पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करता है। विभाग द्वारा सैद्धान्तिकी के साथ ही खाद्य विज्ञान, बेकिंग तकनीक और फल एवं सब्जियों के संरक्षण तकनीक के क्षेत्र में प्रायोगिक अनुप्रयोगों के माध्यम से छात्राओं को दक्ष बनाया जाता है।

The department conducts seminars and workshops on regular basis, which gives students an opportunity to learn about new areas of development in the field of Food Technology and also provides them with a brilliant opportunity to interact with experts from industry as well as academia.

The Department also has a well-equipped laboratory and a commercial oven cum dehydrator to aid the learning process. The students hold exhibition cum sale where they sell the bakery products, preserves and dehydrated products prepared in the laboratory and this helps them to understand the finer details of bulk production, packaging, costing and selling.

भूगोल विभाग

भूगोल मानविकी का एक महत्वपूर्ण विषय है जिसका विविध क्षेत्रों में अनुप्रायोगिक अवसरों के साथ सैद्धान्तिक एवं व्यावहारिक महत्त्व है। भूगोल विभाग की स्थापना बी.ए. (प्रोग्राम) के विद्यार्थियों के लिए वर्ष 1994-95 में हुई थी। वर्ष 2018 से इस विषय में बी.ए. आनर्स की भी पढ़ाई शुरू हो रही है। पाठ्यक्रम में पूरा ध्यान मुख्यतः भौतिक, मानवीय, आर्थिक, सामाजिक-सांस्कृतिक और पर्यावरणीय पक्षों पर रहता है। इस पाठ्यक्रम में विभिन्न सरणियों के विषय जैसे-प्रादेशिक योजना तथा विकास, भूमि प्रयोग तथा कृषि, नगरीय तथा सामाजिक भूगोल, जीआईएस तथा रिमोट सैसिंग, मानचित्रण के साथ ही विस्तृत कंप्यूटर दक्षता, शोध तथा विश्लेषणात्मक कौशल भी शामिल है।

मानव विकास एवं परिवार सशक्तीकरण

The activities of the department include workshops on preparation of Low cost Teaching Aids, Legal literacy, Theater Workshop etc. The department invites esteemed speakers for talks all through the academic session. The students are also exposed to an element of practical training by being placed in Nursery schools for a short duration in each academic year. The strength of the subject lies in the fact that it is very relevant to understand developmental and socio-economic issues related to children and women and is as such of value in the realities of their daily lives.

विभागीय सभा वर्ष भर प्रतिष्ठित गणितज्ञों तथा शिक्षाविदों द्वारा संगोष्ठियाँ, कार्यशालाएँ, व्याख्यान—माला तथा वृत्ति—परामर्श—सेवाएँ आयोजित करती है। हमारा उद्देश्य पत्र प्रस्तुति, गणितीय प्रश्नोत्तरी, वाद—विवाद तथा प्रज्ञापक—पत्र—निर्माण आदि अंतर्महाविद्यालयीय प्रतियोगिताओं द्वारा छात्राओं का सर्वांगीण विकास करना है। छात्राओं को अपने शिक्षकों के मार्गनिर्देशन में शोध आधारित प्रकल्पों तथा विभिन्न अंतर्महाविद्यालयीय पत्र—प्रस्तुतियों व अन्य क्रियाकलापों के लिए भी प्रोत्साहित किया जाता है। प्रतिवर्ष द्विदिवसीय वार्षिक गणित उत्सव 'सुप्रीमा' का आयोजन भी किया जाता है। इसके अंतर्गत प्रतिष्ठित गणितज्ञों के व्याख्यान तथा अंतर्महाविद्यालयीय कार्यक्रम आयोजित किये जाते हैं। विभाग में प्रतिवर्ष विद्यार्थी परिषद् का भी निर्वाचन किया जाता है तथा वर्ष 2016—2017 से निरंतर भूतपूर्व छात्राओं का सम्मेलन भी किया जा रहा है।

Department of Mathematics

The Department of Mathematics was established in the college in 1972. The department offers the following courses

- **B.Sc. (Hons.) Mathematics**
- **Skill Enhancement courses (SEC) to students of B.Sc. (Hons) Mathematics**
- **Generic Elective (GE) courses in Mathematics for students of B.A. (Hons.)/ B.Sc. (Hons) Computer Science / B.Com(Hons.)**
- **B.A (Prog.) with Mathematics**
- **Liberal Optional papers in Mathematics for B.El.Ed. students**

The department has highly competent faculty with in-depth knowledge of the subject. The diversity in field of specialization of the faculty members is a major strength of our department. The department extensively uses ICT Facilities and Software's like Mathematics and Maxima to help students visualize and appreciate the mathematical concepts and their applications in everyday life. The practical classes are very enriching and help in development of logical and rational thinking.

The mathematics association organizes Seminars, workshops, Lecture Series and Career Counselling sessions by Eminent Mathematicians and Academicians throughout the year. Our primary focus is holistic development of students which is achieved through Inter-College/Intra-College competitions like Paper Presentation, Mathematical Quiz, Debates and Poster making. The students are encouraged to do Research based projects under

supervision of our faculty and participate in various Inter College Paper presentations and co-curricular activities. Annual Mathematics Fest "Suprema" is organized every year. It is two day program involving workshop/lecture by eminent mathematicians and Intercollege / Intra college events. Department elects Students Council every year. Alumni meet is a regular feature since 2016-17.

संगीत विभाग

महाविद्यालय में सन् 1972 में संगीत विभाग स्थापित किया गया। यहाँ गायन एवं वादन (सितार) दोनों श्रेणियों में संगीत सिखाया जाता है। यहाँ निम्नलिखित पाठ्यक्रमों में एक विषय के रूप में संगीत प्रस्तावित है।

- बी.ए. (प्रोग्राम)
- बी.ए. विशेष के लिए सामान्य इलेक्टिव

विभाग की एक सक्रिय संगीत सभा 'संगीतिका' भी है। अंतःकक्षीय प्रतियोगिताओं के आयोजन के अतिरिक्त 'संगीतिका' वार्षिकोत्सव का आयोजन भी कराती है, जिसमें प्रख्यात कलाकारों को अपने कौशल, कड़ी मेहनत एवं लगन के प्रदर्शन के लिए आमंत्रित किया जाता है। यह समारोह केवल विभाग की छात्राओं के ज्ञान का विस्तार ही नहीं करता बल्कि पूरे महाविद्यालय के लिए एक समृद्ध सांस्कृतिक कार्यक्रम का रूप ले लेता है।

संगीत विभाग का विषय के रूप में कैरियर के पहलू पर लगातार जोर रहता है, जिससे छात्राओं को इस विषय के माध्यम से मनोरंजन उद्योग तथा शिक्षा में खुलने वाले रास्तों को पहचानने में सहायता मिल सके। हमारी छात्राओं में से कई छात्राओं ने अपनी एम.ए., एम. फिल., पी.एच.डी. सफलतापूर्वक पूरी की है। कई छात्राएं विद्यालयों एवं महाविद्यालयों में नियोजित हैं और कई छात्राओं को आकाशवाणी, दूरदर्शन के कार्यक्रमों में प्रस्तुति का अवसर भी प्राप्त होता रहता है।

Department of Music

The Music department was established in the college in 1972. The department offers music in both categories - Vocal and Instrumental (Sitar). It offers music as a subject in following courses:

दर्शनशास्त्र विभाग

दर्शनशास्त्र को बी.ए. प्रोग्राम में एक वैकल्पिक विषय के रूप में प्रस्तावित करने हेतु सन् 1974 में यह विभाग स्थापित किया गया। सन् 1995 में महाविद्यालय में दर्शनशास्त्र में बी.ए. विशेष प्रारम्भ किया गया और इस प्रकार यह महाविद्यालय इस पाठ्यक्रम को प्रस्तावित करने वाले दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के कुछ चुनिंदा महाविद्यालयों में शामिल हो गया।

वर्तमान में, विभाग में दर्शनशास्त्र में बी.ए. विशेष तथा विविध प्रकार के विषयों का शिक्षण होता है जैसे—तर्कशास्त्र, नीतिशास्त्र, पाश्चात्य दर्शन, यूनानी दर्शन, भारतीय दर्शन, सामाजिक और राजनैतिक दर्शन, धर्मदर्शन, नारीवाद, मन (बुद्धि) के दर्शन आदि। विभाग बी.ए. प्रोग्राम की छात्राओं के लिए अनुशासन के रूप में और अन्य बी.ए. विशेष की छात्राओं के लिए सामान्य इलेक्टिव और एस. ई.सी. का भी पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करता है। विभाग में अंग्रेजी तथा हिन्दी दोनों माध्यमों में अध्यापन कार्य होता है।

विभाग की अपनी एक दार्शनिक सभा भी है जिसकी सदस्यता लेना बी.ए. विशेष की छात्राओं के लिए अनिवार्य तथा बी.ए. प्रोग्राम की छात्राओं के लिए वैकल्पिक है। संस्था समस्त शैक्षणिक सत्र में विभिन्न प्रकार के कार्यक्रमों और गतिविधियों से विद्यार्थियों का ज्ञान वर्धन करती है, वाद-विवाद, संगोष्ठियों, कार्यशालाओं और अनेक प्रतियोगिताओं का आयोजन भी करती है। संस्था प्रख्यात शिक्षाविदों तथा संबंधित क्षेत्र के पेशेवरों को महाविद्यालय की छात्राओं को व्याख्यान देने के लिए भी आमंत्रित करती है।

Department of Philosophy

The Department was established in 1974 to offer Philosophy as an optional subject in B.A. Programme. In 1995, the college started B.A. Honors in Philosophy and joined a group of few select colleges of Delhi University to offer this course.

Presently, the Department offers B.A. Honors in Philosophy and teaches a diverse range of subjects such as Logic, Ethics, Western Philosophy, Greek Philosophy, Indian Philosophy, Social and Political Philosophy, Philosophy of Religion, Feminism, Philosophy of mind, etc. The Department also offers philosophy as a discipline for B.A.

Programme students and Generic Elective Course to students of other Honors courses. The Department teaches in both English and Hindi medium.

The Department also has a Philosophy Association. The membership is compulsory for Honors students and optional for B.A. Programme students. The Association conducts various events like debates, seminars, workshops, and essay competitions throughout the academic year. The association also invites eminent academicians and field professionals to deliver lectures to college students.

Along with the curriculum, the students of Philosophy are trained in analytical and logical reasoning, which gives them an edge over their competitors in various entrance exams. Such skills enable the students to gain logical thought and coherent expression, which assist them in the pursuit of their professional careers. The students are also equipped with the knowledge required to become a liberated educated person

शारीरिक शिक्षा विभाग

शारीरिक शिक्षा विभाग, सैद्धांतिक और प्रायोगिक रूप में निम्नलिखित पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करता है—

- बी.एल.एड द्वितीय वर्ष (स्वास्थ्य एवं शारीरिक शिक्षा)
- स्नातक विषयों के लिए सामान्य ऐच्छिक (इलेक्टिव) पाठ्यक्रम

विभाग छात्राओं को अपनी प्रतिभा—प्रदर्शन के साथ उन्हें प्रशिक्षित, मेहनती और सफल पेशेवर के रूप में संवारने हेतु निरंतर कार्यरत है। महाविद्यालय में खेल के राष्ट्रीय स्तर के बेहतरीन और खुले मैदान हैं। छात्राओं को बस पास, नवीनतम खेल उपकरण और सामग्री के साथ प्रतिदिन जलपान भी उपलब्ध कराया जाता है। खेल के क्षेत्र में उत्कृष्ट प्रदर्शन करने वाली शैक्षणिक व्यय वहन करने में अक्षम छात्राओं को महाविद्यालय वित्तीय सहायता भी प्रदान करता है। महाविद्यालय विभिन्न खेलों जैसे हॉकी, खो—खो, कबड्डी, बॉलीवाल, बेसबाल, बास्केटबाल, लॉन टेनिस, हैंडबॉल, सॉफ्टबॉल, पावर लिफ्टिंग और वजन प्रशिक्षण में छात्राओं के प्रशिक्षण के लिए वर्ष भर राष्ट्रीय स्तर के खेल—प्रशिक्षकों को आमंत्रित करता है।

Department of Physical Education

The Department of Physical Education offers theory and practical papers to the students of the following course:

- **B.El.Ed. II year (Health and Physical Education)**
- **Generic elective for B.A. (Hons.)**

The department is constantly engaged in grooming students to display their talents along with training them to be hardworking and successful professionals. The college is equipped with national level and well-maintained sports ground and fields. The students are provided with latest sports equipment and gear along with daily refreshment and bus passes. राजनीति शास्त्र विभाग

संस्कृत विभाग

हमारे महाविद्यालय में संस्कृत विभाग का आरंभ महाविद्यालय की स्थापना के साथ ही सन् 1969 में हुआ। विभाग निम्नलिखित पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करता है—

- बीए (विशेष) संस्कृत
- बीए (प्रोग्राम) में संस्कृत
- स्नातकोत्तर स्तर पर संस्कृत

संस्कृत अनुशासन बहुत विविध है। पाठ्यक्रम का बल मूलतः साहित्य (प्राचीन एवं आधुनिक), पाणिनीय व्याकरण, भारतीय दर्शन, भारतीय वैज्ञानिक धरोहर, भारतीय तर्कशास्त्र, वादविद्या, संस्कृत भाषाविज्ञान, वैदिक साहित्य, सौन्दर्यशास्त्र, रंगमंच एवं साहित्यशास्त्र, प्राचीन गणित विज्ञान एवं खगोलशास्त्र, धर्मशास्त्र, पुरालेख विद्या एवं प्राचीन शिलालेखों का अध्ययन, प्राचीन भारतीय राजनीति, वर्तमान में विकसित संगणनात्मक संस्कृत, व्यक्तित्व-विकास तथा पटकथा लेखन पर है। हम छात्राओं को साहित्य के विविध रूपों एवं शैलियों के प्रभावग्रहण में दक्ष बनाने एवं भारत की समृद्ध बौद्धिक परंपरा से परिचित कराने के लिए प्रयासरत हैं। अन्य

विभागों की छात्राओं के लिए हम सामान्य ऐच्छिक (जेनेरिक) पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित करते हैं जो स्वभावतः अंतरानुशासनिक हैं तथा उन्हें एक अतिरिक्त अध्ययन क्षेत्र में भी दक्ष बनाते हैं। इनमें सम्मिलित हैं— भारतीय संस्कृति एवं सामाजिक मुद्दे, भारतीय मनीषा में व्यष्टि, परिवार तथा समुदाय, भारतीय दर्शन के मूल सिद्धांत एवं भारतीय सौंदर्यशास्त्र आदि। हम सभी पूर्वस्नातक छात्राओं के लिए संस्कृत को आधुनिक भारतीय भाषा पाठ्यक्रम के रूप में भी प्रस्तावित करते हैं। शिक्षार्थी की आवश्यकतानुरूप शिक्षण—माध्यम हिंदी, संस्कृत अथवा अंग्रेजी होता है। अपनी रुचि अथवा आवश्यकता के अनुसार छात्राएँ परीक्षा में लेखन के माध्यम के रूप में संस्कृत के अतिरिक्त हिन्दी अथवा अंग्रेजी का विकल्प भी चुन सकती हैं। जिन छात्राओं ने 10+2 के स्तर तक संस्कृत विषय नहीं पढ़ा है, वे भी संस्कृत विशेष में प्रवेश ले सकती हैं तथा बीए (प्रोग्राम) स्तर पर संस्कृत का चुनाव कर सकती हैं। बी.ए. प्रोग्राम संस्कृत में प्रवेश लेने वाली छात्राओं को अधिकतम 5%-10% तक की छूट दी जा सकती है। विभागीय सभा छात्राओं के कौशल—संवर्द्धन हेतु कई अंतः एवं अंतर—महाविद्यालय स्तर के कार्यक्रम आयोजित करती है जिनमें शामिल हैं—सस्वर श्लोक पाठ प्रतियोगिता, प्रश्नोत्तरी, संभाषण, वाद—विवाद, अभिनय, काव्यालि एवं निबंध लेखन। समय—समय पर हम अपनी छात्राओं को अकादमिक भ्रमण पर भी ले जाते हैं। प्रत्येक वर्ष एक शिक्षक के साथ एक छात्रा को महाविद्यालय पत्रिका श्यामा के संस्कृत खंड के संपादन का अवसर प्राप्त होता है। परीक्षा में उत्कृष्ट अंक प्राप्त करने वाली छात्राएँ छात्रवृत्ति भी प्राप्त करती हैं।

Department of Sanskrit

The Department of Sanskrit at our College came into being in the year 1969, with the establishment of the College in the same year. The Department offers following courses:

- **B.A. Honors in Sanskrit**
- **Sanskrit in B.A. Programme**
- **M.A. in Sanskrit**

The discipline of Sanskrit is highly diversified. The focus of the curriculum is mainly on: Literature (classical and modern), Paninian Grammar, Indian Philosophy, Indian Scientific Heritage, Indian Logic and Science of Debate, Sanskrit Linguistics, Vedic Literature, Aesthetics, Theatre and Poetics, Ancient Mathematics and Astronomy, Dharmashastra, Epigraphy and Paleography, Ancient Indian Polity, Computational Sanskrit, Personality Development and Script Writing. We attempt to enable students to appreciate different forms and genres of literature and to become aware of the rich intellectual traditions of India.

For the students of other departments we offer Generic Elective courses which are of interdisciplinary nature and aim to enrich students in an additional field of study. They include, Indian Culture and Social Issues; Individual, Family and Community in Indian Social Thought; Fundamentals of Indian Philosophy; and Indian Aesthetics. We also offer Sanskrit as MIL for all undergraduate students. The medium of instruction is Hindi, Sanskrit or English, as per the requirements of the students. Mode of examination can be Hindi, English & Sanskrit. The students who have not studied Sanskrit in the 10+2 level are also eligible for admission in Sanskrit (Honors) as well as Sanskrit (Programme) courses. Those girls who will take admission in B.A. Programme in Sanskrit can get 5%-10% relaxation in Marks.

Our Departmental Association conducts many co-curricular activities at inter-college and intra college levels for students to hone their skills in areas such as shloka recitation, quiz, speech, debate, acting, kaavyaali and essay

writing. Occasionally we take our students for academic excursions also. Brilliant students will get scholarship also. Every year a student along with a teacher is given an opportunity to edit the Sanskrit Section of the College magazine 'Shyama'.

समाजशास्त्र विभाग

समाजशास्त्र विभाग बी.ए. (प्रोग्राम) पाठ्यक्रम के साथ 1990 में स्थापित किया गया था। छात्राओं को समाज शास्त्रीय अवधारणाओं और सिद्धान्तों से परिचित कराते हुए उस सैद्धान्तिक समझ को जीवन के वास्तविक अनुभवों से जोड़ना और संबंधित करना सिखाकर पाठ्यक्रम दोहरे दायित्व का निर्वाह करता है। समाजशास्त्र छात्राओं को दैनिक घटनाओं को एक व्यापक परिप्रेक्ष्य में देखने और समाज को और बेहतर एवं समालोचनात्मक तरीके से समझने के लिए प्रोत्साहित करता है।

समाजशास्त्र का परिचय, भारत का समाजशास्त्र, समाजशास्त्रीय अवधारणाएं तथा समाजशास्त्रीय अन्वेषण की प्रविधियां जैसे प्रपत्र बी.ए. प्रोग्राम पाठ्यक्रम में शामिल हैं। ये प्रमुख पत्र विषयों की एक विस्तृत शृंखला जैसे संस्कृति, समाजीकरण, जाति, वर्ग, जनजाति, गांव, महिलाओं के आंदोलन, दलित आंदोलन, सांप्रदायिकता, धर्मनिरपेक्षता तथा प्राचीन विचारकों जैसे कार्ल मार्क्स, एमिल दुर्खीम एवं मैक्स बेबर आदि को समाहित करते हैं। समाजशास्त्र के अध्ययन के द्वारा छात्राएं समाज में प्रचलित असमानता और अन्याय पर प्रश्न करना सीखती हैं। यह बेहतर और विकसित समझ उनके व्यक्तित्व विकास में मदद करती है।

संकाय छात्राओं को पुस्तकों की परिधि से बाहर का ज्ञान देने की दिशा में कठिन परिश्रम करता है। कक्षा व्याख्यान समसामयिक समाजिक घटनाओं के संदर्भों से भरे होते हैं। शिक्षण में फिल्मों, समाचार पत्रों और पोस्टरों आदि के प्रयोग पर हमारा बल रहता है। मूल्यांकन एक सतत प्रक्रिया है जो नियत कार्यों, प्रस्तुतियों, परियोजनाओं, परीक्षणों और परीक्षाओं के माध्यम से किया जाता है। अनुशिक्षण वैचारिक स्पष्टता की स्थापना और उनके संदेहों का निदान करने के लिए आयोजित किये जाते हैं।

Department of Sociology

The department of Sociology was established in 1990 with the B.A Programme course. The focus of the course is two-fold: to introduce main sociological concepts and theories to the students and to relate and link the theoretical understanding to the actual experiences of life. Sociology inspires the students to view daily events from a larger perspective and to understand society in a critical way.

B.A Programme includes papers such as Introduction to Sociology, Sociology of India, Sociological Theories and Methods of Sociological Enquiry. These Core papers cover a wide range of topics like culture, socialization, caste, class, tribe, village, women's movements, Dalit movement, communalism, secularism, and classical thinkers such as Karl Marx, Emile Durkheim and Max Weber. Through the study of Sociology, students learn to question the inequalities and injustices prevalent in society. This evolved understanding helps in their personality development.

The faculty strives towards giving knowledge that is beyond books. Classroom lectures are full of references to the current social events. We rely heavily upon the use of movies, newspapers, posters etc. Evaluation is a continuous process that takes place through assignments, presentations, projects, tests and examination. Tutorials are held to establish conceptual clarity and clear their doubts.

सम्बल – आर्थिक सहायता प्रोग्राम

1. आर्थिक दृष्टि से कमजोर छात्राओं के लिए आंशिक अथवा पूर्ण रूप से शुल्क में छूट दी जाती है। शुल्क में छूट के लिए आवेदन निर्धारित प्रपत्र पर जमा कराना होगा जो लेखा विभाग से प्राप्त किया जा सकता है। इसके साथ मजिस्ट्रेट अथवा सिविल अधिकारी/नियोक्ता द्वारा सत्यापित आय प्रमाण पत्र होना आवश्यक है। अच्छी तरह से भरे गए आवेदन इस वर्ष अगस्त तक लेखा विभाग में जमा कराए जा सकते हैं।
2. शुल्क में छूट अच्छे आचरण, नियमित उपस्थिति एवं अध्ययन में संतोषजनक प्रगति पर निर्भर करता है यदि विद्यार्थी इनमें से किसी भी शर्त का उल्लंघन करता पाया जाता है तो यह वापस ली जा सकती है।
3. अनुसूचित जाति एवं अनुसूचित जनजाति की छात्राओं को दिल्ली प्रशासन के शिक्षा निदेशालय से पोस्ट मैट्रिक छात्रवृत्ति प्रदान की जाती है। आवेदन पत्र महाविद्यालय के कार्यालय से प्राप्त होंगे। कार्यालय में जमा करने से पूर्व ये आवेदन पत्र पूरी तरह से भरे हुए एवं आवश्यक दस्तावेजों/प्रमाणपत्रों से युक्त होने चाहिए।

4. सभी आवेदन पत्र महाविद्यालय के कार्यालय से निःशुल्क प्राप्त होंगे। उपर्युक्त छूटों के अतिरिक्त छात्रा सहायता कोष से तदर्थ अनुदान भी दिया जाता है। जो छात्राएं यह सहायता प्राप्त करना चाहती हैं उन्हें छात्रा सहायता समिति के संयोजक से संपर्क करना होगा।
5. दिल्ली प्रशासन, दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय अथवा अन्य ऐजेंसियों द्वारा दी जाने वाली छात्रवृत्तियों की जानकारी समय-समय पर महाविद्यालय के सूचना पट पर उपलब्ध कराई जाती है।
6. महाविद्यालय की ज़रूरतमंद छात्राओं को श्री विजय चंदोला मेमोरियल कोष से अनुदान प्रदान किया जाता है।

SAMBAL- Financial Assistance Program

1. Partial or full fee concession may be granted to the economically weak students. Application for fee concession must be submitted on the prescribed form obtainable from the Accounts Section, duly supported by an income certificate attested by the Magistrate/Civil Officer/Employer. The application complete in all respects must be submitted to the accounts section, latest by August in the year.
2. Fee concessions granted are subject to good conduct, regular attendance and satisfactory progress in studies and may be withdrawn anytime if a student is found neglecting any of these.
3. Students belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes are awarded Post-Matric Scholarships by the Directorate of Education, Delhi Administration. Forms will be available in the College Office. These should be filled in neatly, accompanied by necessary certificates/documents before submission in the office.
4. All forms will be available in the college office free of charge. In addition to the above concessions, ad-hoc grants may be given from "Student Aid Fund". Students desiring to avail this aid must contact the Convener of Students Aid Committee.
5. Notices of scholarships granted by Delhi Administration, University of Delhi or other agencies are displayed on the College Notice Board from time to time as and when they are received.
6. Shri Vijay Chandola Memorial Fund is given to the needy students of the college.

संकाय सदस्यों एवं छात्राओं के लिए एक अधिगम संसाधन के रूप में पुस्तकालय की एक महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका है। महाविद्यालय के पुस्तकालय में ओपेक (ओपन लाइन पब्लिक कैटलौग) पद्धति स्थापित की गई है जिससे पुस्तकालय के संसाधनों तक त्वरित एवं आसान पहुंच संभव हो, इसके परिणामस्वरूप पुस्तकालय में उपलब्ध विभिन्न संसाधनों की अद्यतन स्थिति ज्ञात होती है।

पुस्तकालय में पाठ्य-पुस्तकों तथा संदर्भ पुस्तकों का बहुत अच्छा संग्रह है जिसमें शामिल हैं— विश्वकोष, वार्षिकी, शब्दकोष, एटलस, सामान्य ज्ञान की पुस्तकें, सामान्यतः पढ़ी जाने वाली पुस्तकें, जीवनियां, आत्मकथाएं तथा साथ ही अंग्रेजी और हिंदी भाषाओं के नवीन उपन्यास। हमारे संग्रह में लगभग 77016 पुस्तकें, 78 पत्र-पत्रिकाएं, हिंदी और अंग्रेजी के 11 दैनिक अखबार एवं इलेक्ट्रॉनिक संसाधन, शामिल हैं जैसे यूजीसी इन्फोनेट, सीडी, डीवीडी, ई-पत्रिकाएं एवं ई पुस्तकें। यहां एक बुक बैंक भी है जो आर्थिक दृष्टि से कमजोर वर्ग की छात्राओं की मदद के लिए अंतरराष्ट्रीय पंजाबी सोसायटी के अनुदान द्वारा चलाया जाता है। पुस्तकालय में ब्रेल में लिखी पुस्तकों का संग्रह भी उपलब्ध है।

पुस्तकालय के सूचना केंद्र में छात्राओं की परियोजना और शोध कार्य के लिए इंटरनेट की सुविधा से युक्त 25 कंप्यूटर भी हैं। डी.यू. एल.एस/यूजीसी इन्फोनेट के माध्यम से समग्र पाठ्य जानकारी के साथ यहां 6000 से भी अधिक पत्रिकाओं की सुलभता, ई-संसाधन, ई-पुस्तकें, ई-आंकड़े भी संपूर्ण एवं संक्षिप्त जानकारी के साथ डाउनलोड किए जाने के लिए निःशुल्क उपलब्ध हैं। सूचना केंद्र वाई-फाई की सुविधा से युक्त है। पुस्तकालय परिसर सभी प्रयोक्ताओं के लिए वाई-फाई युक्त क्षेत्र है। दिव्यांग छात्राओं के लिए रिकॉर्डर और खास सॉफ्टवेयर के साथ लैपटॉप भी उपलब्ध हैं।

पुस्तकालय के विषय में कुछ और जानकारी—

1. पुस्तकालय का कुल क्षेत्र 7116.32 वर्ग मीटर है।
2. पुस्तकालय में 150 छात्राओं के बैठने की जगह है और संकाय सदस्यों के लिए भी एक वाचनालय है।
3. दिव्यांग व्यक्तियों के लिए पुस्तकालय में एक लिफ्ट भी है।
4. शनिवार एवं रविवार के अतिरिक्त पुस्तकालय सभी दिन सुबह 8.30 से सायं 5.30 तक खुलता है।

LIBRARY

Library plays a significant role as a learning resource center for the faculty and students. Our library is fully computerized with the catalogue in Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) form for easy and quick access to all resources. Students and teachers can check the availability of books and journals in the library from various terminals and get them for issue, reference or photocopy.

The library has a rich collection of text books and reference books, which includes encyclopedias, yearbooks, dictionaries, atlases, general knowledge books, general reading books, biographies, autobiographies and latest fiction in English and Hindi languages. Our collections include nearly 77016 books, 78 journals and periodical subscriptions, magazines, 11 daily newspapers in English and Hindi, and electronic resources including online databases through UGC INFONET, CDs, DVDs, e-journals, and e-books. A book bank that runs with the help of grants from International Punjabi Society helps the students from economically weaker sections. A Braille book collection is also available in the library.

The Information Centre in the library has 25 computers with internet facility for the students to do their assignments and research work. Free access to more than 4000 journals with full text information, e-resources, e-books, e-databases are available through UGC INFONET. The Information Centre has Wi-Fi connectivity. Library premises are a Wi-Fi enabled zone for all users. Recorders and laptops with special software are available for the differently-abled students.

Some more information about the library:

1. Total area of the library is 7116.32 square meters.
2. The library has a seating capacity of 150 students and also has reading room for faculty.
3. The library has a lift facility for the differentially abled.
4. The library opens at 8.30 am and closes at 5.30 pm on all the days except Saturday and Sunday.
5. The Library has three floors:
6. The College Library has installed OPAC to enable easy and quick access to library resources, which gives the latest status of various resources available in the library.

श्यामा प्रसाद मुखर्जी महाविद्यालय का समान अवसर प्रकोष्ठ 'संबल' दिव्यांग छात्राओं एवं अध्यापकों की अध्ययन-अध्यापन संबंधी विशिष्ट आवश्यकताओं की पूर्ति के लिए निरन्तर प्रयासरत है। सम्पूर्ण महाविद्यालय परिसर में दिव्यांगजनों की सुगमतापूर्वक पहुँच को सुनिश्चित करने हेतु लिफ्ट, रैम्प, स्पर्शनीयपथ दिव्यांगजनों हेतु विशिष्ट शौचालय आदि अनेक आवश्यक सुविधाओं को उपलब्ध कराया गया है। दिव्यांगजनों के सशक्तीकरण एवं स्वावलंबन के लिए प्रकोष्ठ द्वारा आधुनिक उपकरण जैसे – डेजी वाइस रिकार्डर, स्क्रीन-रीडर साफ्टवेयर लेपटाप आदि प्रदान किये जाते हैं। विकलांगता संबंधी मुद्दों, चुनौतियों एवं समस्याओं के विषय में सामान्य छात्राओं को जागरूक करने के उद्देश्य से प्रकोष्ठ द्वारा प्रतिवर्ष अनेक सांस्कृतिक गतिविधियों, विशिष्ट व्याख्यानों एवं कार्यशालाओं का आयोजन भी किया जाता है।

• Equal Opportunity Cell : Sambal

The equal opportunity cell of the college is a great source of inspiration for the differently abled. The college provides infrastructure facilities like ramp, tactile pathways, elevators and special toilets. Sambal conducts a variety of activities that aims to sensitize the general student body about the challenges that its members face. The college provides hundred percent fee waivers to the differently abled. Special counselling is done during admissions to facilitate their entry into the college.

The college provides sophisticated aids and equipments like ANGEL recording system and LEX screening machine that enables the differently abled to function with greater ease. Constant efforts are made to introduce new aids in the college so as to serve the interest of the differently abled better. Cultural events like 'Kavi Sammelan' are held which bring to light the multifaceted abilities of the differently abled.

MEDICAL COMMITTEE AND FAMILY COUNSELLING CENTRE (FCC)

The college has an active Medical Committee with a full time trained nurse. FIRST AID FACILITY is also available for the students. 4. ORDINANCES AND OTHER RULES

4.1 ORDINANCES

4.1.1 ORDINANCE XV-B

Maintenance of discipline among Students of the University

1. All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action are vested in the Vice - Chancellor.
2. The Vice-Chancellor may delegate all or such powers as he / she deems proper to the Proctor and to such other persons as he/she may specify in this behalf.
3. Without prejudice to the generality of power to enforce discipline under the Ordinance the following shall amount to acts of gross indiscipline:
 - a. Physical assault, or threat to use physical force, against any member of the teaching and nonteaching staff of any Institution / Department and against any student within the University of Delhi
 - b. Carrying of, use of or threat to use of any weapons
 - c. Any violation of the provisions of the Civil Rights Protection Act, 1976
 - d. Violation of the status, dignity and honour of students belonging to the scheduled castes and tribes
 - e. Any practice-whether verbal or otherwise-derogatory of women
 - f. Any attempt at bribing or corruption in any manner
 - g. Willful destruction of institutional property
 - h. Creating ill-will or intolerance on religious or communal grounds
 - i. Causing disruption in any manner of the academic functioning of the University system;
 - j. Prohibition of Ragging as per Ordinance XV-C.
4. Without prejudice to the generality of his / her powers relating to the maintenance of discipline and taking such action in the interest of maintaining discipline as may seem to him/her appropriate, the Vice-Chancellor, may in the exercise of his / her powers aforesaid order or direct that any student or students -
 - a. be expelled; or
 - b. be, for a stated period rusticated; or
 - c. be not for a stated period, admitted to a course or courses of study in a College, Department or Institution of the University; or
 - d. be fined with a sum of rupees that may be specified; or
 - e. be debarred from taking a University or College or Departmental Examination or Examinations for one or more years; or that the result of the student or students concerned in the Examination or Examinations in which he /she or they have appeared be cancelled.

5. Institutions, Halls and teaching in the concerned Departments. They may exercise their authority through, or delegate authority to such of the teachers in their Colleges, Institutions or Departments as they may specify for these purposes.
6. Without prejudice to the powers of the Vice-Chancellor and the Proctor as aforesaid, detailed rules of discipline and proper conduct shall be framed. These rules may be supplemented, where necessary, by the Principals of Colleges, Heads of Halls, Deans of Faculties and Heads of Teaching Departments in this University. Each student shall be expected to provide himself/herself with a copy of these rules. At the time of admission, every student shall be required to sign a declaration that on admission he/she submits himself/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Vice-Chancellor and several authorities of the University who may be vested with the authority to exercise discipline under the Acts, the Statutes, the Ordinances and the rules that have been framed therein by the University.

4.1.2 ORDINANCE XV-C

Prohibition and Punishment for Ragging

1. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited, within the premises of College/Department or Institution and any part of Delhi University system as well as on public transport.
2. Any individual or collective act or practice of ragging constitutes gross indiscipline and shall be dealt with under this Ordinance.
3. Ragging for the purposes of this Ordinance, ordinarily means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant power or status of senior students is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are in any way considered junior or inferior by other students; and includes individual or collective acts or practices which
 - a. involve physical assault or threat to use of physical force.
 - b. violate the status, dignity and honour of women students.
 - c. violate the status, dignity and honour of students belonging to the scheduled caste and tribe.
 - d. expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self-esteem.
 - e. entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behavior.
4. The Principal of a College, the Head of the Department or an Institution, the authorities of College, or University Hostel or Halls of Residence shall take immediate action on any information of the occurrence of ragging.
5. Notwithstanding anything in Clause (4) above, the Proctor may also suo moto enquire into any incident of ragging and make a report to the Vice-Chancellor of the identity of those who have engaged in ragging and the nature of the incident.

6. The Proctor may also submit an initial report establishing the identity of the perpetrators of ragging and the nature of the ragging incident.
7. If the Principal of a College or Head of the Department or Institution or the Proctor is satisfied that for some reason, to be recorded in writing, it is not reasonably practical to hold such an enquiry, he/ she may so advise the Vice-Chancellor accordingly.
8. When the Vice-Chancellor is satisfied that it is not expedient to hold such an enquiry, his/her decision shall be final.
9. On the receipt of a report under Clause (5) or (6) or a determination by the relevant authority under clause (7) disclosing the occurrence of ragging incidents described in Clause 3(a), (b) and (C), the Vice-Chancellor shall direct or order rustication of a student or students for a specific number of years.
10. The Vice-chancellor may in other cases of ragging order or direct that any student or students be expelled or be not for a stated period, admitted to a course of study in a college, departmental examination for one or more years or that the results of the student or students concerned in the examination or examinations in which they appeared be cancelled.
11. In case any students who have obtained degrees or diplomas of Delhi University are found guilty; under this Ordinance, appropriate action will be taken under Statute 15 for withdrawal of degrees or diploma conferred by the University.
12. For the purpose of this Ordinance, abetment to ragging whether by way of any act, practice or incitement of ragging will also amount to ragging.
13. All Institutions within the Delhi University system shall be obligated to carry out instructions/directions issued under this Ordinance, and to give aid assistance to the Vice-Chancellor to achieve the effective implementation of the Ordinance.

Note: Order of the Vice-Chancellor in pursuance of Ordinance XV-C:

Where incident(s) of ragging are reported to the Vice-Chancellor by any authority under this Ordinance, the students(s) involved in ragging, shall be expelled for a specified term, designated in the order. Nonstudents involved in reports of ragging will be proceeded with under the criminal law of India; they will also be rendered ineligible for a period of five years from seeking enrolment in any of the institutions of the University of Delhi. Students against whom necessary action is taken under this note, will be given post decisional hearing, with strict adherence to the rules of natural justice.

4.1.3 Ordinance XV-D

The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (MINISTRY OF LAW AND JUSTICE)

An Act to provide protection against sexual harassment of women at work place and for the prevention and redressal of complaints of sexual harassment and for matters connected there with incidental thereto.

WHEREAS sexual harassment results in violation of the fundamental rights of a woman to equality under articles 14 and 15 of the Constitution of India and her right to life and to live with dignity under article 21 of the Constitution and right to practice any profession or to carry on any occupation, trade or business which includes a right to a safe environment free from sexual harassment;

AND WHEREAS the protection against sexual harassment and the right to work with dignity are universally recognized human rights by international conventions and instruments such as Convention on the Elimination of all forms of discrimination against Women, which has been ratified on the 25th June, 1993 by the Government of India.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make provisions for giving effect to the said Convention for protection of women against sexual harassment at workplace.

4.2 ATTENDANCE RULES

In order to be eligible to appear at a University Examination every student has to attend a minimum of two thirds of the lectures, parcticals and tutorials/perceptorials held during the semester, considered separately.

Ordinance VII, Clause 2-A, Part (ii) states:

The Principal of a college shall have power to strike off the name of a student who is irregular in attendance for such a long period that she cannot put in requisite percentage of attendance.

Students seeking concession on:-

- (i) Medical ground should submit a separate medical and fitness Certificate from the appropriate authority. Medical certificate only for serious sickness will be considered.
- (ii) Sports ground should submit a Certificate from the Sports teacher within a week after participation in the event.

In no case will the concessions granted under (i) & (ii) or in any combination thereof exceed one third of the total number of lectures delivered.

Every student admitted to the College for the Academic session 2018-19 shall be compulsorily required to sign an undertaking that she will fulfil the minimum attendance requirements failing which the College shall have the right to take necessary action.

Note:

1. Students should carefully note that attendance rules are prescribed by the University and no relaxation is possible. **THESE RULES ARE RIGIDLY AND STRICTLY ENFORCED. THE PRINCIPAL'S DECISION IN THIS REGARD SHALL BE FINAL AND BINDING.**
2. It is the responsibility of the student or her guardian to ascertain periodically from the college website the state of attendance No personal communication will be done.

3. Application for medical leave will be entertained only if it reaches the college within **10 days**.
4. Students should regularly see the Notice Board website for circulars pertaining to attendance.

4.3 OTHERS

4.3.1 सूचना—पट्ट

यह प्रत्येक छात्रा का उत्तरदायित्व है कि वह प्रतिदिन सूचना—पट्ट देखें। किसी भी आदेश की अवहेलना के लिए यह तर्क स्वीकार नहीं किया जाएगा कि सूचना पढ़ी नहीं थी। यही बात विश्वविद्यालय की परीक्षाओं, परिणाम, नामांकन, छात्रवृत्तियाँ, वजीफों व अन्य प्रपत्रों पर भी लागू होगी जिन्हें महाविद्यालय के कार्यालय द्वारा घोषित अनुसूचित तारीखों पर जमा कराना होता है। यह छात्राओं का कर्तव्य है कि वे सूचना—पट्ट को विभिन्न तारीखों की जानकारी के लिए देखें तथा उन्हें बताई गई अंतिम तिथि तक अपने विकल्प जमा कराएँ। अंतिम तिथि के बाद किसी अनुरोध पर विचार नहीं किया जाएगा।

Notice Board

It is the responsibility of each student to check the Notice Board daily. No excuse for noncompliance with any order, based on the plea that the Notice was not read shall be accepted. The same applies to notifications issued by the University with regards to Examinations, Results, Enrolment, Scholarships, Stipends and other forms, which should be submitted as per scheduled dates announced by the College Office. It is the duty of the students to check the notice board for the dates and also submit their options by the last date intimated to them. No request will be entertained after the last date.

4.3.2 पहचान पत्र

पहचान पत्र सभी छात्राओं को प्रदान किए जाते हैं। नई छात्राओं को प्रवेश के तुरंत बाद पहचान पत्र प्राप्त कर लेना चाहिए। अन्य छात्राओं को महाविद्यालय के कार्यालय से प्रत्येक वर्ष अपने पहचान पत्र को नवीकृत कराना चाहिए। महाविद्यालय परिसर में एवं उसके बाहर प्रत्येक छात्रा के लिए पहचान पत्र साथ रखना अनिवार्य है। महाविद्यालय के अधिकारियों द्वारा मांगे जाने पर छात्रा को अपना पहचान पत्र प्रस्तुत करना चाहिए अन्यथा हो सकता है कि उसे महाविद्यालय परिसर में रहने की अनुमति न मिले।

Identity Card

Identity Cards are issued to all the students. Newly admitted students must obtain their Identity Cards immediately after their admission. Other students should get their Identity Cards renewed from the College office every year. It is essential for every student to carry her Identity card in the College as well as outside. A student should produce her Identity card on demand by the College authorities failing which she may not be allowed to stay on the College premises.
