

Talk of English Department organised on 20 February 2018

The Literary Society, Shyama Prasad Mukherji College, organised a panel discussion on "Creative Impulses: Understanding the process of writing" and invited three young writers who have recently published their works to discuss the process of writing and publishing with the students of our college. The panellists Noor Anand, Karan Kapoor (authors of *The Dreaming Reality*) and Laveena Behl (author of 'Beyond the veil of love: An atypical analysis of the emotion called love'), discussed at length the very basics of creative fiction writing and also detailed and circulated their write-up on the topic, "How to write a debut novel". The discussion started with a brief interview conducted by Hemanshi Arora and Shivani Chawla (English (H) 2 year) who asked them about their literary inspiration, about their process of editing their works and their journey to a published book. After the interview, the discussions began and various enthusiastic and budding writers from our audience brainstormed on concepts of drafting, free writing and inventive thinking. The session ended with a 10 min reading of their respective works by the authors.
