Research Assistant: PhD/MPhil/Post-graduate in a social science discipline with a minimum of 55% marks. Prior experience in field research, editing, and report writing is preferable.

Field Investigator: Post-graduate in any social science discipline with a minimum of 55% marks.


Research Intern: (Under)graduate in any social science and humanities with prior experience in research, writing, data analysis, data collection, etc.


Work Description:

- The research staff are required to contribute to the management and research tasks of this project, assisting in administrative work, field visits, data collection, analysis and report writing. Candidates should be highly motivated to learn on the job, committed to the project work, and have a flair for teamwork. Research staff are required to travel to Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Jharkhand, and Uttar Pradesh for 2-4 months to undertake field research.
- The continuation of selected candidates for project work is subject to the satisfaction of the Principal Investigator/Project Director/Project Coordinator. The period and number of research staff appointments may vary from 1 month to a maximum of 6 months.
