

Call for Applications for Research Staffs in ICHR sponsored Research Project

Designation: Full time Research Assistant (Two Positions) on contractual basis and Filed Investigator/Assistant (Four Positions). The positions are initially for four months. The number and duration of vacancies may increase or decrease.

Application Requirements
