Grievances regarding GE and SEC subjects allocations (V & VI semester)

Dear Students,

You have been allotted GE and SEC subjects for the next academic session (V and VI semesters, 2021-2022). The allocations were made on the basis of the 4 subject preferences that you filled in GE/SEC Google forms.

Subjects were allotted on the basis of availability – once a subject was filled beyond capacity, the remaining students who had opted for it as their first preference, were allotted their next viable preference.

In many cases, students had opted for invalid subjects (your GE subject cannot be the same as your main disciplines/your SEC subject must be one of your main disciplines or language papers) – despite the fact that the rules for selection had been clearly defined in the PPT, notices, the counselling sessions, and in the college forms. Further, a few students did not fill their Google forms within the given deadline. Multiple circulars as well as personal emails were sent to notify such students, and all the students were allotted subjects that were valid AND available.

Please be assured that you have all been given subjects that are VALID and ENRICHING, whether those were your first preferences or not, through a massive and comprehensive process where each case was considered carefully. Shifts from one subject to another are neither possible nor advisable. Do not disturb your studies by second guessing your own or the committee's decisions. Please join and attend the classes of the subjects that you have been allotted, and in case you have any doubts about the scope of the subject you have been given, consult your SEC/GE teachers once the session begins. Your teachers would be more than happy to address your queries and doubts. Good luck for the new session!
