Maintenance Allowance for courses other than Tech. and Prof. Courses at UG and PG Level: INR 570/- per month for Hosteller and 300/- per month for Day Scholar.		

For M. Phil and Ph.D, INR 1200/- per month for Hosteller and INR 550/- per month for day Scholar. (Who are not awarded any other scholarship by University or any other authority)
