17. Library Development

Our library is fully computerized with a database of about 80,000 books. It has a rich collection of books and reference on various disciplines. The college allocate Rs. 15,22,500.00 for library development in 2019-20, out of which the Rs. 12,50,994.62 was spent. The development fund of the library was Rs. 9,37,500.00 of which Rs. 4,51,725.00 was spent. 2056 books were added in this year. 1822 books were purchased and 234 books added through donated collection. During the year, the library subscribed to 23 journals, 46 magazines, and 11 newspapers. In this year, the library had a total membership of 3966 including 180 teachers. The information centre in the library has 25 computers with internet facility for accessing e-resources. Login passwords are also provided to all members for free access to more than 6000 journals, e-database available through UGC-INFONET. The library has a unique braille books collection. Recorders and laptops with special software are issued to differently-abled students for the entire duration of their courses.
