## Goals:

“Introduce participants to website development tools, languages and frameworks. Students were made to learn **HTML5, CSS3, JavaScript, J. Query, PHP5, database MySQL** and working of CMS- **Word Press**. Combination of these skills increases the job opportunities of any individual, giving them an edge in Information Technology sector.”

## Resources:

· At the cost of ₹1000 per student, the **seven day** workshop proved to be extremely beneficial and enlightening. With added benefit of **everyday refreshments, 34 participants**, seated in computer **lab 35**, felt very satisfied with desktops at the college, many even carried their own laptops.

## Attendance:

· The instructor cleared the doubts of the students, before 8:30am and after 4pm, and also during breaks, that is, **he stayed for extra hours** than allotted and entertained doubts of students. Therefore, many doubts and confusion of students were cleared, and this resulted in total of **only five** individual marked **absentees** over a duration of 7 days, by 34 participants.

· The sessions were extremely interactive, instructor made sure everyone was on same pace making the enrolled proud of their investment in the workshop. He asked questions to keep tickling our curious nerves. He also gave and **corrected home assignments regularly**.

## Results:

· As a combined effort of the teacher and students, every participant tried to **mimic the teacher’s pre-existing website: <http://indasfundas.in/>** and many were successful. Students can now make basic html templates with almost no problems and create beautiful transitions and effects with CSS3 and JavaScript easily!

· Also, students have the Email id of the teacher to seek his help in future, so we are never stuck anywhere. This promotes his quality of being considerate and dedicated to his teaching profession and hobby.

· This event was one of its kinds and cannot be simply compared to any other event I attended in my first year of college.

· Students returned home **satisfied and impressed** and more open to new cutting edge technologies in the field of website development.

## Reactions:

· Feedback given by the participants shall motivate the teachers to keep organizing workshop like these in future to increase our skills demanded by placement authorities.
