

Call for Applications
for Research Staffs in National Commission for Women sponsored Research Project

Project: "Challenges in Cyberspace for Women: A Study of Delhi and Select Regions of NCR in 2020-21", sponsored by National Commission for Women (NCW), Delhi.

Designation: Full-time Project Co-ordinator/Research Officer (1 Position for 12 months), Field Co-ordinator/Research Associate (3 Positions for 6 months), Research Assistant (4 positions for 3-6 months), Field Investigator (10 Positions for 1-2 months) on contractual basis. The number and duration of vacancies may increase or decrease as per the need for the research work.

Essential Requirements

- Applicants for the posts of Project Coordinator/Research Officer, Field Co-ordinator/Research Associate and Research Assistant are required to hold a Master degree in any relevant disciplines including Political Science/Sociology/ History/ Psychology/Management/Gender Studies/Criminology/Statistics may apply.
- The students pursuing graduation or holding graduate or post-graduate degrees, knowing 'challenges in cyberspace for women', prior experience of survey research and the ability to conduct field survey may apply.

Desirable:

- The applicants must know some of the cases of women related cyber-crime. They should possess the ability and interest to explore and interact with the women complainant of cyber-crime, Police officials (IOs), NGOs, judicial officials and policymakers dealing with the issues of cyber-crime.

Work Description:

- Project Coordinator/Research Officer, Field Co-ordinator/Research Associate and Research Assistants are required to contribute to the management and research tasks of this project, assist in administrative work, literature and data collection, report writing and search cases of women related cyber-crimes and conduct interviews with the complainants, Police officials, NGO representatives, Judicial personals and policymakers.
- The Field Investigators are required to search the cases of cyber-crimes and conduct interviews with them. Their main task would be to visit educational institutions to conduct both qualitative and quantitative surveys in various colleges in Delhi including 4 districts of NCR regions i. e. Gurgaon, Faridabad, Ghaziabad and Noida. Preference will be given to those candidates who would show their reach to the cases of women related cyber-crimes.

Pay: The selected research staffs will be paid as per NCW's guidelines and the decision of the selection committee. Field Investigator shall be paid lumpsum honorarium as decided by the

selection committee. No TA and DA will be paid to those who will be called for an interview. The location of posting will be New Delhi

(2) Statement of purpose (500 words) explaining how this project will benefit the applicant and how the applicant can contribute to the project by exploring the cases of women related cyber-crimes in Delhi and select regions of NCR.
